## **ON-CAMPUS FILM SHOOT PERMITS**

<u>NO</u> student is permitted to film on campus <u>without</u> faculty supervision, and a Use of Facilities Permit <u>must</u> get filed with the Facilities Programming Department. There is a five (5) day turn around for Facilities Requests. Please contact Linda Sullivan at 310-434-3427.

## OFF-CAMPUS FILM SHOOTING/CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE

- The film project must obtain a Certificate of Insurance. If student is shooting a short film in the City or County of Los Angeles, student must contact FilmL.A., Inc., at 213-977-8600 to receive permit instructions and to confirm they cover the location where students will be shooting their short film. If FilmL.A., Inc. does not cover the location, student will need to contact the City Office of that location to obtain a copy of their INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

CERTIFICATE(S) OF INSURANCE WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT THE DOCUMENTS REFERENCED ABOVE.

Student must submit all forms referenced above to Adriene Smith at <u>ariass\_glaurys@smc.edu</u> 7-10 days prior to a film shoot to obtain a certificate of insurance.
