
Support Services for Special Programs

- The Disabled Students Programs and Services/Learning Disabilities Program provides tutoring in mathematics, English, science, and other subjects for students with documented learning disabilities. Approximately 120 students are served in this center Mondays through Fridays in the Mathematics Complex.
- The Pico Promise Transfer Academy offers mathematics tutoring to participants in this program, which is funded by the City of Santa Monica. Hours vary depending on need.
- TRIO Student Support Services provides tutoring in mathematics and English to participants in this program, which is funded by the U. S. Department of Education. Hours vary depending on need. (This program offering ended as of August 31, 2015, when the College's grant request to the U.S. Department of Education was not funded.)
- The Scholars Program provides tutoring in English to program participants two days a week (Monday and Wednesdays) from 9 am to 1 pm.
- The Guardian Scholars Program serves current and former foster youth enrolled at the College, and offers one-on-one tutoring in math. The program currently provides services 20 hours per week.
- The Extended Opportunity Programs and Services provides English, mathematics, and science tutoring to program participants Monday through Friday during flexible hours based on student demand.
- The Latino Center/Black Collegians Center offers tutoring three days a week in a variety of subjects, including English, mathematics, chemistry and physics.
- The Veterans Resource Center offers tutoring in a variety of subjects Monday through Thursday.
- The Science and Research Initiative offers drop-in tutoring in conjunction with the Latino and Black Collegians Centers, utilizing funding from the U.S. Department of Education Title III Hispanic Serving Institutions and STEM Articulation Program.
