The Chairs of Excellence are grants awarded to exceptional faculty members striving for innovative avenues to advance the opportunities of our students in this global environment.

The Chairs of Excellence have been established for specific academic disciplines by the generous donations of individuals and corporations. Each chair is established with an endowment of \$100,000 or more, and maintained as separate fund within the permanently restricted portfolio of The Santa Monica College Foundation.

Each applicant is required to submit a proposal for the three-year project. The \$15,000 is awarded over the 3-year period at \$5,000 per academic year.

PROPOSAL

1. Summarize your proposal request including goals and outcomes.
2. Why is this grant necessary to achieve your stated goals and outcomes?

3. How will your project impact student success?

4. How will this enhance your professional development?

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be full-time faculty in the Chair's designated discipline. NOTE: Seniority at SMC is not a factor, new faculty are encouraged to apply.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

The selection committee will meet prior to the end of the academic year, at which time finalists may be asked to make a 10-15 minute presentation in defense of their proposal.

AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT

The recipient is announced at the fall Opening Day ceremonies.

DISBURSMENT OF AWARDS

- Recipient must submit a W-9 form for the distribution of award and is responsible for reporting award to IRS.
- Funds are dispersed in increments of \$5,000 per academic year, over a 3-year period. Recipients may select payment in one of the three following ways:

1. Full amount in September (fall);
2. Full amount in February (spring); or,
3. ½ in September and ½ February

FINAL REPORT

- A final report is required by **September 1** detailing expected goals, and current and future outcomes as a result of the award; and,
- Final accounting of expenditures.
 - Including photos and quotes from students, faculty and staff are greatly appreciated.

THE SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee will be comprised of college administrators, SMCF board members, and/or Foundation donors.
