



ARTICLE 1200 ROLE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

BP 1265 Superintendent/President Succession

1. The Board of Trustees delegates authority to the Superintendent/President to appoint an acting Superintendent/President to serve in his or her absence for short periods of time, not to exceed 30 calendar days at a time.
2. In the absence of the Superintendent/President and when an acting Superintendent/President has not been named, administrative responsibility shall reside with:

Executive Vice-President
Vice-President, Business and Administration
Vice-President, Academic Affairs
Vice-President, Human Resources
Vice-President, Student Affairs

3. If the absence exceeds three consecutive months, the Board shall appoint an acting or interim Superintendent/President.
4. In the case of resignation, retirement or death of the Superintendent/President, the Board shall establish a search process. The Board may appoint an interim Superintendent/President for up to one year. It shall appoint an interim if the time available to conduct a search is less than six months.

BP 1266 Selection of Superintendent/President

In the event of vacancy in the position of Superintendent/President, the Board of Trustees shall establish a search process to fill the vacancy. The process shall comply with relevant regulations.
