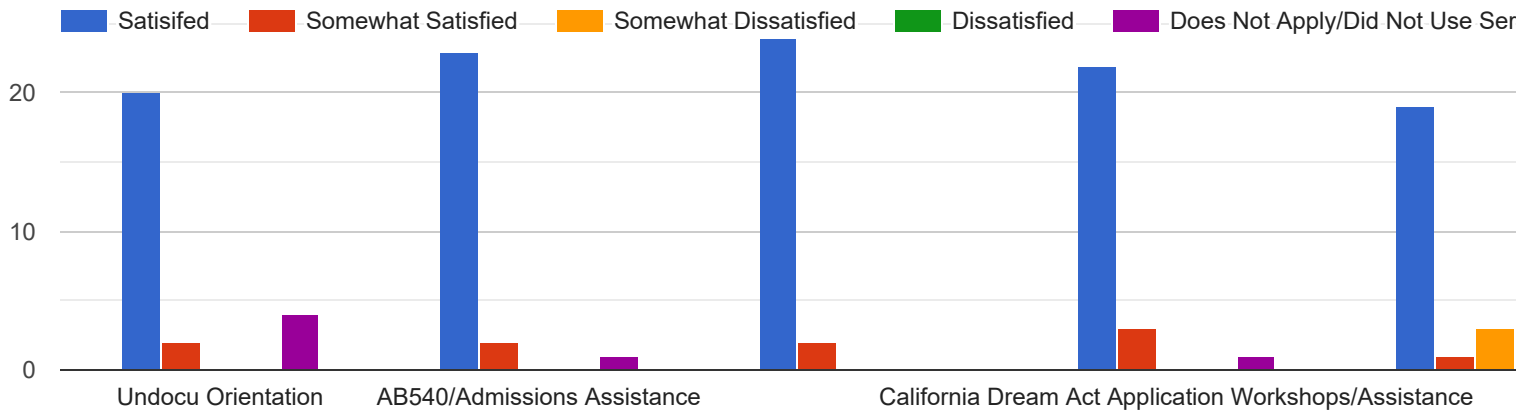

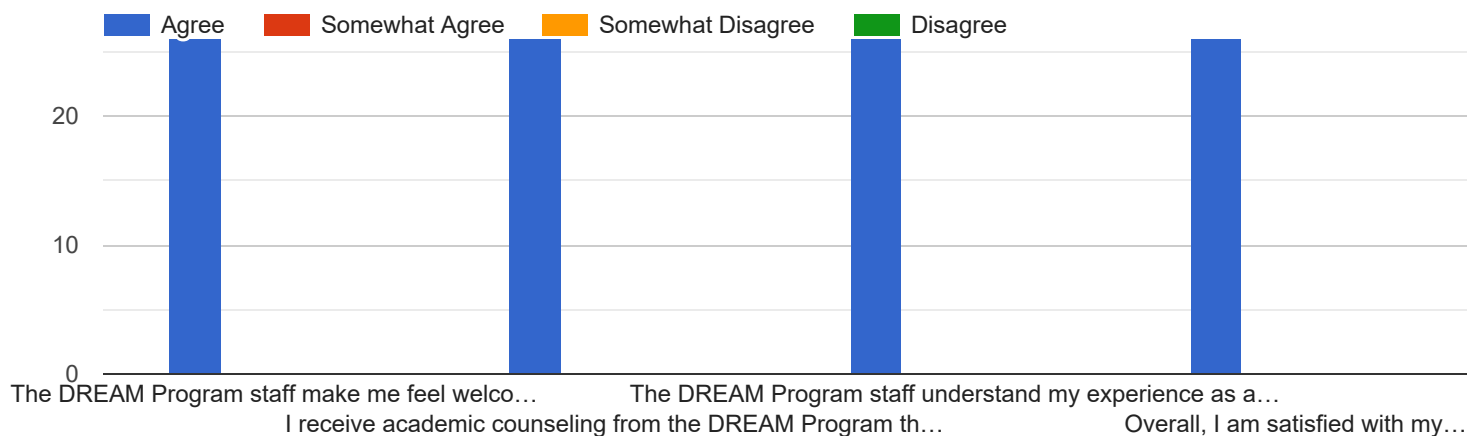

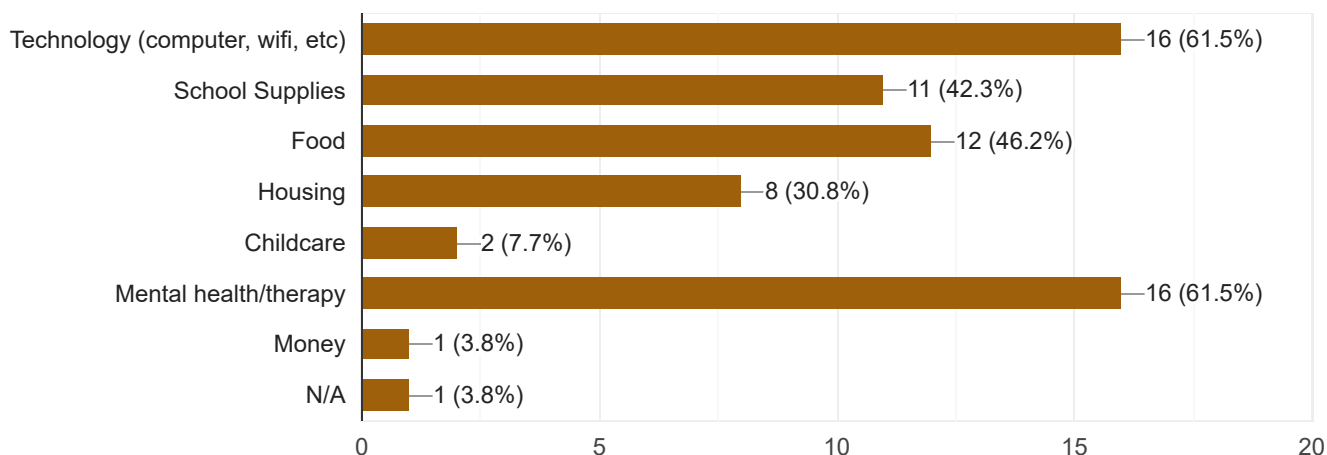
Maybe include a mandatory check in in order for students to be encouraged to use the counseling resources
