Perkins Allocation Discussion

We sent the summary list to Erica LeBlanc to see what could be covered by Lottery funds. Please review the document and make sure all your items are included. We'll be using this as a reference when submitted the Perkins grant application to the Chancellor's Office as long as the items are allowable. This list will also be sent to Georgia Lorenz and Dr. Jeffery for final approval. Professional Development funds will be included in the New Program Development – Across Programs section as in previous years.

Recommendations for New Program Development and Approval Process

Jenny Merlic drafted a document to streamline the new program and course approval process, specifically for CTE programs. There was a directive from the Chancellors Office to have a process for both local and regional approval. This document will be presented to the Curriculum Committee along with any changes the CTE Committee would like to make. The Curriculum Committee is formalizing the receipt of information from departments regarding department certificates and their purpose – fulfilling labor market demand and creating stackable certificates to serve as milestones for students.

We would like to capture more completions as this would increase funding. The process is the same in terms of the program/course needing to go through Curriculum, Academic Senate, and the Board of Trustees. The only thing different is supplying the application with labor market information. Advisory Board minutes (a template can be found on the CTE Shared drive) should be attached to justify the creation of a new program/course but an employee survey can be used in lieu of the minutes.

MIS is working on auto-awarding Department Certificates which will help with a systematic way of tracking the certificates. We have submitted a department certificate under ECE as an experiment in Degree Audit. Jenny will follow up to see what the status is and will look at the



number of units required for department certificates and certificate of achievements. The committee expresses the importance of having stackable certificates to serve as milestones for students, as well as routing students to the correct degree/pathway based on identifying the student population – new students, or those retraining for the workforce.

The committee suggests having a near future discussion with Jennifer Merlic regarding internship courses and SAM Code assignments.
