#### **Old Business**

Curriculum Update – Brenda Antrim

The new funding model does not allow for locally approved certificates to be considered as a completers. Certificate of Achievements are now considered between 8 and 15 ½ units. Anything over 16 units requires approval from CCCCO. Stackable certificates must be free-standing but may need additional clarification. The student centered funding formula will be phased in over three years.

The CTE Committee mentions students are required to complete a certain percentage of courses at SMC for awards. Other schools do not have that policy. This may be a disadvantage for SMC

A quick overview on CurruNet – if departments have a certificate that includes classes from two departments, identify the goal of the program to determine the type of certificate it should be – in terms of considering the program a CTE program certificate. California uses TOP Codes, Federal Codes reference SOC Codes. Looking up SOC codes can help determine the TOP code. In CurricuNet, courses have both a long and short name. the short name is listed on the student transcript – Academic Affairs determines the name.

CTE faculty members have requested access to the list of short names listed on student transcripts for reference.

Curriculum Debrief – the LAOCRC website has samples of program applications that can be used as reference. You can submit the LMI form to Ruth Casillas and she'll submit the information through the Center of Excellence.



The counselor sheets should be updated. This data found is taken from CurricuNet. An updated version of these has been designed by the IxD students through Steven Sedky's Marketing subcommittee goals. He will continue to meet with counselors to update the sheets.
