Other Related Items	<ol> <li>The Board of Trustees must, no later than January 1, 2019, certify that it has adopted goals that are aligned with the Vision for Success, adopted by the Board of Governor's in 2017. The CCCCO is charged in the legislation to provide guidance to the Districts on how to meet this requirement.</li> <li>The Legislature will create a Student Success Funding Formula Oversight Committee for the purpose of continuous evaluation of the new funding formula.</li> </ol>
