## Regina Ip addressed ways to publish the Equity Guide:

- With the guide on Canvas, we can just add a link on the webpage. PDF is not recommended as it is not as mobile friendly or accessible.
- The guide is text heavy, which does not lend itself well to a webpage.
- Tables need to be made mobile friendly and accessible.
- The worksheets/practice pages, as well as case studies, could be kept as pdfs to fill out.
- Consider who would have access to edit (on Canvas or the website), the website has more controls over accessibility, broken links, spell checks than Canvas
- Since the guide is more instructional, Regina recommends using Canvas since it has the ability to format for the instructional style
- Videos added should always be captioned, can be used in Canvas or the website
- Canvas shell can't be linked to website unless public sharing is enabled
- Accessibility of content is monitored and supported more on the website by Regina and Paul
- Can make it so that the guide pops up as result of equity search on website
- Need to think about what the purpose of the guide is to determine where it fits best – more visually appealing maybe best for website, or a training course may be best for Canvas. Also consider what the intended audience (faculty) are most comfortable with
