  - <u>Introduction/Guidelines</u> for "<u>Model Syllabus</u>" [discussion of student syllabus use]:
    - Responses to purpose of the syllabus: most responses were regarding clear policies, expectations, deadlines.
    - The most useful information for students relates to "logistics" not necessarily the tone of the class (schedule, grading, exam dates, assignment descriptions).



- Tone of syllabus: some students underscored the importance of directness (keeping things short and simple) while others underscore the importance of a warm, personal, tone.
- o Things that make a syllabus difficult to understand: too long, inconsistent layout.
- o What would make a syllabus helpful: direct, clear, organized.
- o Instead of revamping the model syllabus do we solely provide recommendations?
- Create a video/power point to accompany the written model syllabus to meet faculty where their needs are. Which committee will do this work?
