XII. Information Items

- a. OER Grantee Workshop postponed to November 1st. Not all grantees can attend the new date, so an online makeup session will be scheduled at a later date.
- b. Open Education Conference, takeaways – reclaiming authors publishing rights (Authors Alliance – Rights Reversion).
 - Roxana attended the OE Conference in-person, Evelyn attended virtually. There were a lot of great sessions, and they recommended future attendance.
 - One session featured the Authors Alliance, which supports authors in reversing their copyright permissions to themselves from publishers so that they can relicense their work in a more open fashion.
 - Can the OER Committee help make this information more accessible for faculty when examining resources?
 - Can the OER Committee investigate copyright clearance and SMC copyright policy?
 - Walter will investigate how to initiate the process for establishing an institutional copyright policy at SMC as it currently does not have one.

- c. **ASCCC OERI: Accessibility Basics** - Intended to introduce all faculty to the basics of developing accessible content and provide faculty who will be developing and/or curating open educational resources (OER) with an understanding of accessibility basics. It's a self-paced course.
- Great resource to review and use when assessing different OER
 - Suggestion to share with DE to incorporate into Canvas trainings
