V. Chair's Report

Questions were raised about whether the proctoring service would be expanded beyond STEM disciplines and whether it would also serve departments like Nursing. There were also suggestions to engage the Associated Students to gather additional feedback.

The committee reviewed the previous recommendation to transition to Honorlock for the 2026–2027 academic year and identified next steps for outreach and engagement:

- V. Malzone and T. Whitaker will coordinate outreach to STEM department chairs and distribute webinar details to collect questions and feedback ahead of the presentation.
