I. Call to Order: 12:00 PM

II. Public Comments: None

III. Welcome and Introductions

Administrator Catherine Weir joined Student Affairs Committee as a new voting member.

IV. Approval of Minutes: September 18, 2019

Motion to approve Minutes as is, Esau moved, Tom seconded, (7) Yes, (1) Abstention: Catherine at 12:04pm.

## V. Review of Scope and Functions of Committee

a. The Committee read and decided not to change any language from the previous year's version of Scope & Functions of the Student Affairs Committee.

Motion to approve Scope & Functions as is, Esau moved, Mike seconded, (8) Yes at 12:08pm.

- b. Student Members (Voting and Non-Voting)
  - a) Past practice: two voting members with one-week notice of replacement.
  - b) Two voting members determined by Associated Students.
  - c) Replacements allowed with one-week notice from Associated Students to Committee chair.

Motion to Approve Student Members, Mike moved, Bridgette seconded, (10) Yes at 12:14pm.

- c. Voting Members Faculty and Administrators
  - i. Suggestion that administrators can elect voting replacement in the event of an absence.
    - a) Past practice: not allow faculty and administrator voting replacements. Has not been an issue.
    - b) Without notice, it could create problems.
    - c) Would treat faculty and administrators differently.
    - d) Response that DPAC allows substitutions for administrators.



- e) Suggestions:
  - i) Postpone official votes should faculty outnumber administrators due to absences. It's a joint committee. Last meeting first time we didn't reach consensus.
  - ii) Administrators allowed to vote by E-mail. Knowing if a majority vote may be an issue.

Changes tabled for further clarification on whether faculty and/or administrative members can send replacements.

## VI. Old Business: Update

- a. AR's 5410, 5420, 4225, 4226
  - i. 5410, 5420, and 4226 to be submitted to Executive Committee's next meeting
  - ii. 4225, due to no mutual agreement, will be reviewed by SMC President and Academic Senate President

#### VII. New Business:

- a. AR 5017 Responding to Inquiries of Immig. Status, Citizenship Status and Nat'l Origin Info
  - i. Procedure is legally required. Districts must adopt language from the Office of the California Attorney General or locally created equivalent language.
  - ii. Problematic language in paragraph 2, ...the District shall not use that documentation or information for decisions related to admissions or enrollment...
    - a) F-1 students require F-1 visa to be admitted.
    - b) Other visa types also affect admissions.
    - c) Language changed to *In those circumstances in which federal or state law authorizes such an inquiry, the documentation or information shall be used only in accordance with such federal or state law.* Language appended to the end of the first paragraph.
  - iii. Fifth paragraph changed from [designate] to Dean of Enrollment Services, or designee.
  - iv. Suggestion to exclude from this AR examples of documents that can be used as proof of residency documents and following three paragraphs as these are outlined in AR 4110.
  - v. Guidelines to cover topics in this AR are being drafted by Campus Counsel.
  - vi. Campus Counsel recommended changing title of this AR to Making Inquiries...
    - a) Guidelines will operationally address how to respond to inquiries.
    - b) Responding to Inquiries would be a separate AR, number to be determined by Campus Counsel.

#### Motion to Approve AR 5017 with changes, Esau moved, Bridgette seconded, (10) Yes at 12:46pm.

- b. AR 5203 Lactation Accommodation
  - i. Required by January 2020.
  - ii. Need reasonable accommodations, including a location.
    - a) AR does not restrict location to that place.
    - b) Main campus lactation room located on third floor of Student Services Center.



- c) Room must provide a table, a sink, and access to a power source for a breast pump or any other equipment used to express breast milk.
- iii. Advanced notice for faculty
  - a) Standardized accommodation form to be drafted and made available to students.
  - b) Academic Affairs to remind faculty of reasonable accommodations.
- iv. Title IX Coordinator to identify location of lactation rooms for satellite campuses.
  - a) Mark on campus maps
  - b) Identified in campus materials (e.g. student handbook), etc.
- v. Responsible party for complaints
  - a) Informal: In the event of noncompliance, students are encouraged to meet with the department chair, faculty chair, or Academic Affairs to address the concern.
  - b) Formal: Complaint of noncompliance may be filed using the standard Title 5 complaint process administered by Human Resources.
- vi. Highlighted on its respective campuses changed to at each of its campuses.

### Motion to Approve AR 5017 with changes, Alicia moved, Donna seconded, (10) Yes at 1:11pm.

- c. Walkthrough for ARs 3900, 5430, 5431, 4300, and 5570
  - i. Language is long but specific.
    - a) Principal mission is education.
    - b) Need to manage College properties to be used for intended purposes of student education.
    - c) Language adopted from several sources.
    - d) More details may prevent legal trouble.
  - ii. General overview
    - a) Obtained AR numbering
    - b) Events combined with use of college property
    - c) Added credit card marketing
  - iii. Not a style manual can reorder
    - a) Introduction discusses free speech and use of college properties.
    - b) Headings readable by screen readers for persons with disabilities.
    - c) AR is comprehensive to promote reading of the entire document rather than portions.
  - iv. General Comment: Thoroughness would provide a way to deescalate without the use of police.
- d. AR 3900 Use of C. Property for Speech & Other Act.

Committee did not review this AR. Postponed to next meeting.



#### e. AR 5430 Student Clubs

- i. Paragraph B
  - a) College does not want to be affiliated to all clubs or club activities.
  - b) Removed which act independently of the College.
  - c) Under the Associated Students Constitution, a club may be formed for any purpose.
  - d) Language changed to A club may be formed for any lawful purpose, including academic, social, political, or religious purpose. The College does not direct the purposes of student clubs.
- ii. Paragraph I
  - a) Student club names are not college names.
  - b) College name before club name implies it is the College's club.
  - c) College name after club disassociates it from a College activity.
  - d) Sanctioned clubs have access to Associated Students funding, rooms, and facilities.
  - e) College has authority to discipline behavior that occurs during official field trips.
  - f) The act of organizing a field trip makes it official.
- iii. Request to adopt language to this AR from AR 5431 Paragraph G.
- iv. Comment: Faculty should know that attending an unofficial club activity will make them personally liable.
- v. This AR renamed to Formation of Student Clubs.
- vi. Inter-Club Council votes to approve clubs.

Committee did not complete the review of this AR. Postponed to next meeting.

f. AR 5431 On-Campus Events by St Org's & Clubs

Committee did not review this AR. Postponed to next meeting.

g. AR 4300 Field Trips and Extra-Curricular Activities
