#### A. Students on Probation, compared to students enrolled in credit courses




Figure 1. Fall 2016 Cohort Ethnicity/Race Representation



Overall, students of nearly all Race/Ethnic groups from both Fall 2015 and Spring 2016 cohorts who participated in BTS were more likely to end the subsequent semester(s) in Good Standing than students who did not participate in BTS sessions.
