Student Affairs Committee

Scope:

The Committee evaluates and updates all administrative regulations concerning student affairs, including but not limited to admissions and registration, student progress and graduation, student conduct, student activities, counseling, and financial aid.

Functions:

- Develops and revises administrative regulations. Ensure that new or revised changes to administrative regulations are in compliance with Title 5 and California

 Education Codes. When these issues are addressed in Title 5 and the California Education Code, ensure that changes are in compliance with relevant guidelines. (while particularly paying attention to equity guidelines?)
- Reviews district board policies concerning student affairs matters, and when appropriate, recommends changes. reviews district board policy relevant to administrative regulation and may recommend changes.
- Interfaces with any senate committee that addresses student affairs.
