## **AR 4312 Faculty Initiated Grade Changes**

It is a recognized principle that evaluation in college courses is a prime responsibility of the instructor. Such evaluation involves measurement of achievement against the objectives of the course, and the assignment of a letter grade to denote the subject matter mastery of the student reflect this assessment. Grades (A, B, C, D, F, P, NP) assigned by the faculty are considered to be final and will only be changed in cases of clerical or computational error. Faculty must report errors no later than two years following the date of the grade submission report and include a brief written explanation and/or relevant documentation of the clerical or computational error.
