

**Initial Suggested Changes to the Program Review Process**  
(Approved unanimously by Program Review Committee at 4/20 meeting)

1. Create two tracks for SMC's Program Review Process: one for Administrative Units and another for Instructional and Student Support Service Programs, recognizing that there will be some programs that would be reviewed in both tracks, such as Campus Police, Institutional Research, and Human Resources.
  
2. Pause six-year (not annual) Program Review for the 2021-2022 academic year to allow the Academic Senate Program Review Committee, with input from relevant stakeholders, to devote its meetings, and time and energy to finalizing the new process, and especially, to developing the new report templates for programs to use and the new rubric(s) that the committee will use to evaluate the program reports once the new process starts for the 2022-2023 academic year.
