*Whereas*, Santa Monica College’s current Mission statement states:

*“Santa Monica College provides open and affordable access to high-quality undergraduate degrees and certificates, and participates in partnerships with other colleges and universities to facilitate access to baccalaureate and higher degrees. *Whereas*, President/Superintendent Dr. Jeffery chose to cancel the hiring of 11 new full-time faculty;

*Whereas*, there have been additional cuts to current and future sections and counseling hours due to a **budget** deficit.

**Be it Resolved**, that the Academic Senate of Santa Monica College continues to urge the District to develop a detailed plan to exit hold harmless and maximize opportunities within the SCFF while ensuring student access to courses and support services.
