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Beginning Fall *Onboarding*

Introductory meetings with campus groups.
October transition meeting with previous Guided Pathways leads.



November/December *Planning*

Formation of the Guided Pathways (GP) Collaborative with Equitizing Gateway Courses Leads.



January *Winter Gathering*

Gathering of the cross-role GP Collaborative to set a common understanding of systems change and racial equity.



March *Micro-Learning*

The GP Collaborative connected with four campus groups: Career Services Center, Financial Aid & Scholarships, Outreach & Recruitment, and Peer Navigators.



April/May *Develop Recommendations*

The GP Collaborative met over multiple meetings to discuss the student journey and develop recommendations.



June and Summer *Dissemination, Planning*

GP Leads refined recommendations into four areas for potential implementation.

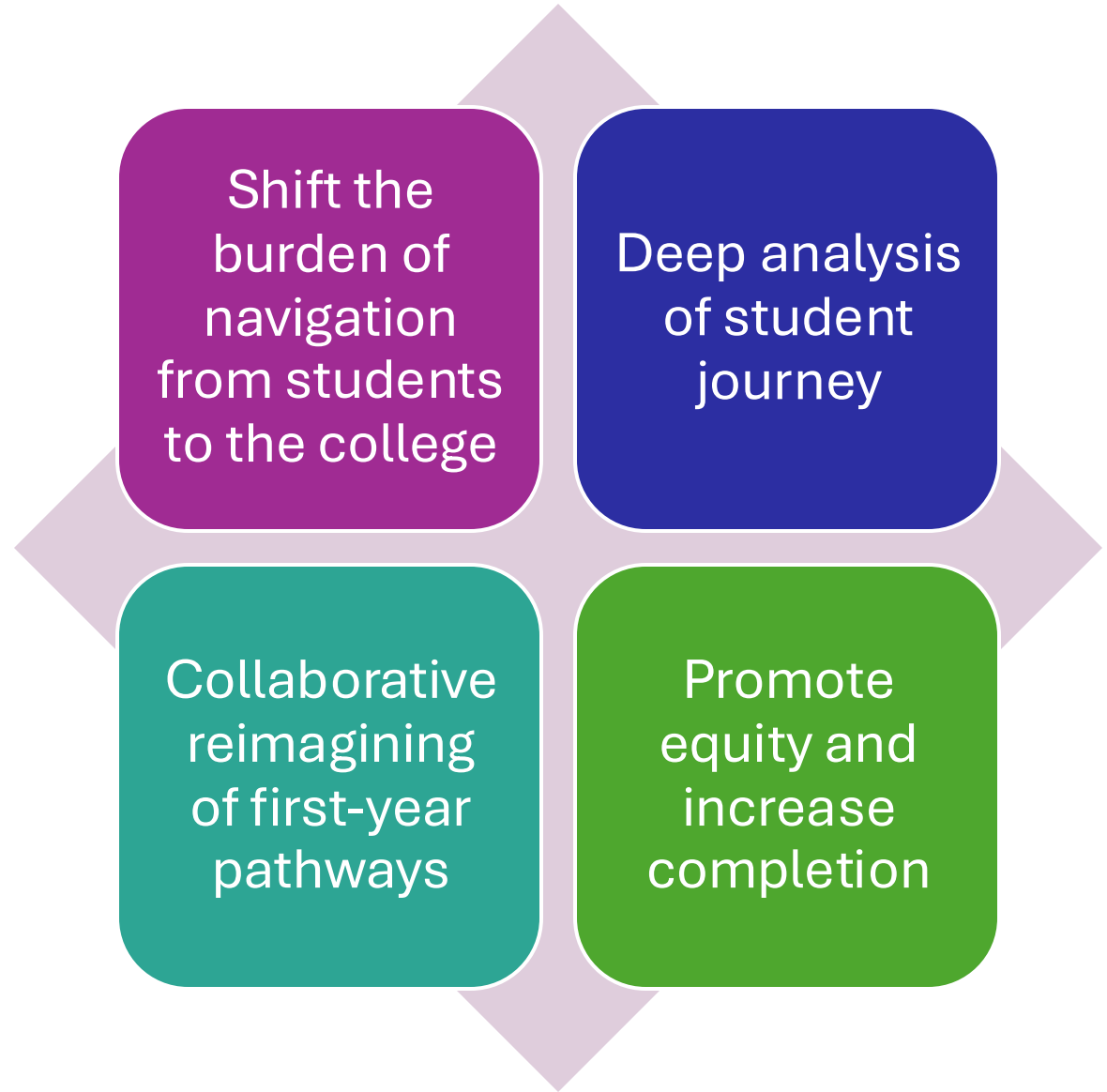

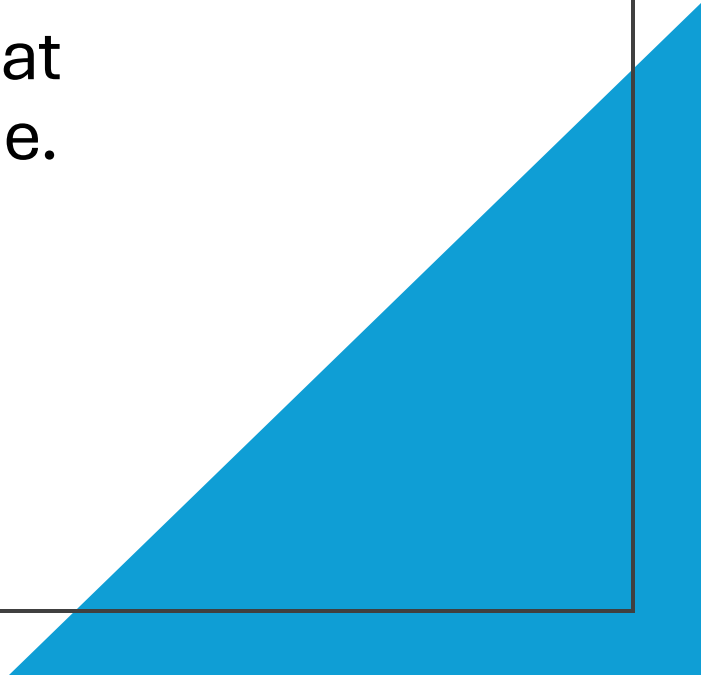

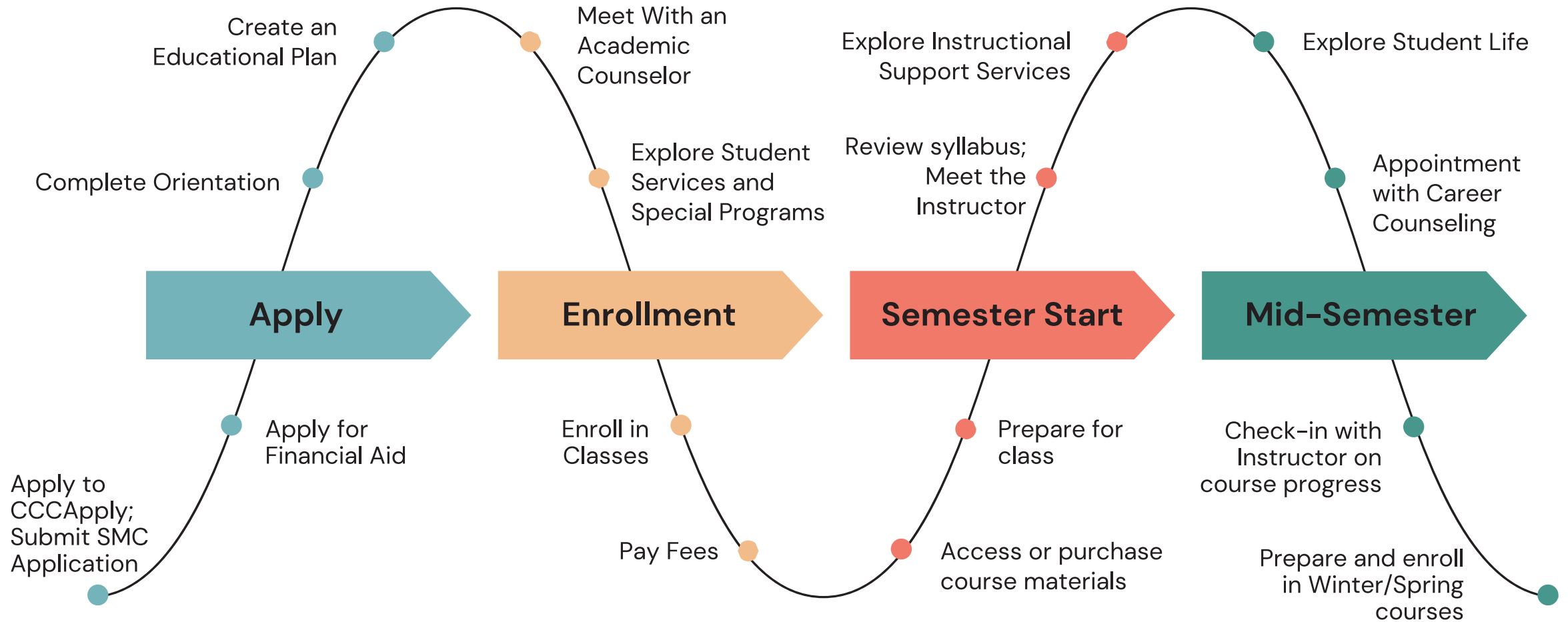
