e. 1st Read AR 5430 (B. Magallon) – Discussion ensued as to why part-time members could lead Study Abroad trips but are not allowed to the primary club advisors. There are not enough full-time faculty for all the current responsibilities restricted to them and part-time faculty can greatly increase the student experience on campus and help retain students by increasing sense of belonging and should be allowed to be primary club advisors.

Simultaneously, the committee should look at revising AR 4420 to allow part-time students to serve as club officers (not Associated Student officers); this will again serve to help retain students and increase sense of connection to campus.

f. Budget – The Senate has committed to compensation for part-time faculty serving as chairs of Senate committees for the 2019-2020 academic year. Discussion ensued various line items, including reducing charitable donation to \$2500 a year, increasing budget for large scale events planned for Adjunct Faculty and whether or not the Senate has the budget to compensate Adjunct faculty for their work.
