H. Stahl updates the committee about the progress of AB 928 (Berman), which automatically places all students who declare a goal of transfer—even those who wish to transfer to UCs—in ADT pathways to transfer to CSUs and creates an intersegmental committee to devise a single pathway to transfer to both CSUs and UCs. H. Stahl notes a lack of consideration among lawmakers for educators' views, as this legislation has advanced despite the ASCCC, CCCCO, FACCC, and various UC and CSU groups opposing the bill. The bill's proponents, including the Campaign for College Opportunity, say it will simplify transfer and support racial equity.
