Chapter 3 – General Institution

AR 3570 Smoke Free Campus

The Santa Monica Community College District is a smoke-free environment. Smoking, vaping, and the use of tobacco products are prohibited in any District building, vehicle, facility or on District grounds at all times. This administrative regulation applies to students, faculty, staff, administrators, visitors, and general members of the public.

This prohibition includes the use of all tobacco products, including electronic devices that deliver nicotine or other vaporized liquids to a person inhaling from the device.

The primary means of enforcement of this regulation is education, awareness and voluntary compliance. If the smoker refuses to comply with a request to refrain from smoking on District property, the person may be subject to disciplinary action and/or referred to Campus Police for enforcement.
