BP 5010 ADMISSIONS AND CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Santa Monica College is open to any graduate of an accredited high school or equivalent and to any other person eighteen years or older who can profit by the instruction. Admission of high school students is permitted under certain conditions.

Admission is dependent upon acceptance of the student, his/her conformance to admission, matriculation, residence qualifications, and payment of required fees. Continual attendance at Santa Monica College is dependent upon satisfactory academic achievement, progress and conduct.
