RE: Protest of Bid Submitted by Environmental Construction, Inc.
District: Santa Monica Community College District ("District")
Project: Track and Field and Scoreboard Replacement ("Project")
Responsive Bidder: Golden Sun Enterprise, Inc. ("GSE")
Non-Responsive Bidder: Environmental Construction, Inc. ("ECI")

Dear Mr. Bonvenuto,

GSE tendered a proposal to the District regarding the Project on September 15, 2025. Upon review of the District's compilation of proposals, a substantial concern arises regarding the bids submitted by the bidder, ECI. This concern warrants the determination that ECI's proposal is nonresponsive and should not be considered by the District.

Prior to delving into the reasons for ECI's bid being deemed nonresponsive, it's imperative to grasp the legal aspects of bidding, as the deficiencies within ECI's proposal directly correlate with each aspect of the framework outlined below as well as the Districts bidding documents and Public Contract Codes.

1. A bid is responsive only if it promises to do what the bidding instructions demand. Williams. v. Clovis Unified Sch. Dist. (2007) 146 CA 4th 757; Valley Crest Landscape Inc. v. City Council (1996) 41 CA 4th 1432, 1438.

2. California courts have also made it clear that they intend for public entities to strictly uphold the standards they set for competitive bidding. As stated by California's Fourth District Court of Appeal: The importance of maintaining integrity in government and the ease with which policy goals underlying competitive bidding may be surreptitiously undercut, mandate strict compliance with bidding requirements. Konica Business Machines U.S.A Inc. v. Regents of University of California (1988) 206 Cal. App.3d 449, 456-457 (Emphasis added.)

3. To be “responsive”, a public works bid must be in strict accordance with the “material” terms of the bid documents. *Menefee v. County of Fresno* (1985) 163 Cal. App.3D 1175.

4. Any “material” variance in a bid may not be waived by the awarding authority, and bids containing “material” variances must be rejected. *Stimson v. Hanely* (1907) 151 Cal.379.

The "material" terms of a bid encompass: (1) factors that could impact price, quantity, quality, or delivery; and (2) terms explicitly outlined as mandatory in the bid document. The deficiencies outlined in this correspondence highlight that ECI's proposal represents a significant "material" deviation, not shared by other bidders.

These principles guarantee equal treatment for all bidders and prevent fraud, corruption, or bias in the bidding process. Essentially, they ensure that the public agency evaluates competing bid proposals fairly and accurately, comparing them on a like-for-like basis.

As evident in ECI's bid submission, it fails to adhere to the instructions and requirements stipulated in the District bidding process, governing bidding laws, and public contract codes.

Grounds for Protest

1- Failure to Provide a Responsive Subcontractor List

ECI overlooked the inclusion of a qualified low-voltage/ Electrical Signs subcontractors in its proposal, contrary to the District's subcontractor listing/bidding requirements outlined (Refer to Exhibit A) and Public Contract Code (PCC) 4104 (a) (1) (Refer to Exhibit B), which mandates the inclusion of subcontractors whose bid exceeds half of one percent of the bidding contractor's proposal. This omitted scope encompasses (a) Scoreboard and Accessories Installation.

Although it holds true that in cases where the General/Prime contractor neglects to designate a subcontractor for work exceeding one-half of 1 percent of the total bid, they must consent to being fully qualified and undertake that portion themselves, this provision does not pertain to ECI. ECI lacks the requisite license classifications (Refer to Exhibit C) and qualifications to carry out certain scopes.

Furthermore, ECI's listed electrical subcontractor similarly lacks the proper license classifications (Refer Exhibit D). According to the California Apprenticeship Council's records (see Exhibit E), ECI's listed subcontractor historically performed only laborer work, not the specialized scope at issue, further evidencing noncompliance.

2- Failure to meet DVBE Participation Requirements

The bid documents (Refer Exhibit F) required bidders to either (a) meet the District's DVBE participation goal, or (b) submit a detailed explanation of good faith efforts and reasons for non-achievement. ECI's bid contains neither. This failure constitutes a material deviation that cannot be waived.

Conclusion

GSE respectfully urges the District to review ECI's non-responsive bid. ECI has evidently failed to comply with the bidding instructions and requirements outlined by the District and Public Contract Codes.

ECI's bid contains significant deficiencies that the District cannot waive. These failures represent a substantial "material" deviation, enabling ECI to pursue illegal avenues post-bid opening by providing an incomplete subcontractor list, which omits a subcontractor for a scope exceeding half of one percent of ECI's proposal.

Furthermore, accepting ECI's bid would establish an unlawful precedent for all future District bids. Therefore, the District cannot accept ECI's bid in its current state.

Golden Sun Enterprise asserts its status as the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, and eagerly anticipates the opportunity to partner with the District on this Project should it be awarded.

District on previous contracts with the Bidder; (b) the Bidder's compliance record with contract general conditions on other projects; (c) the submittal by the Bidder of excessive and/or unsubstantiated extra cost proposals and claims on other projects; (d) the Bidder's record for completion of work within the contract time and the Bidder's compliance with the scheduling and coordination requirements on other projects; (e) the Bidder's demonstrated cooperation with the District and other contractors on previous contracts; (f) whether the work performed and materials furnished on previous contracts was in accordance with the Contract Documents; (v) the previous and existing compliance by the Bidder with laws and ordinances relating to contracts; (vi) the sufficiency of the financial resources and ability of the

Bidder to perform the work of the Contract Documents; (vii) the quality, availability and adaptability of the goods or services to the particular use required; (viii) the ability of the Bidder to provide future maintenance and service for the warranty period of the Contract; (ix) whether the Bidder is in arrears on debt or contract or is a defaulter on any surety bond; (x) such other information as may be secured by the District having a bearing on the decision to award the Contract, to include without limitation the ability, experience and commitment of the Bidder to properly and reasonably plan, schedule, coordinate and execute the Work of the Contract Documents and whether the Bidder has ever been debarred from bidding or found ineligible for bidding on any other projects. The ability of a Bidder to provide the required bonds will not of itself demonstrate responsibility of the Bidder. Upon request of the District, Bidder must promptly submit satisfactory evidence of any of the items listed above. If a Contractor is found to be not responsible, the Contractor may request a hearing to challenge the finding.

16. Subcontractors.

16.1 Designation of Subcontractors; Subcontractors List. Each Bidder shall submit a list of its proposed Subcontractors for the proposed Work as required by the Subletting and Subcontracting Fair Practices Act (California Public Contract Code §§4100 et seq.) on the form furnished. The failure of any Bid Proposal to include the information required by the Act (Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Subcontractors List) will result in rejection of the Bid Proposal for non-responsiveness. No later than 24 hours following the public opening and reading of Bid Proposals, the Bidders submitting the three (3) lowest Bid Proposals shall submit to the District the California Contractor's State License Number and dollar value of the work of each and every Listed Subcontractor (Columns 4, 5 and 6 of Subcontractors List). Failure of any of the three (3) lowest Bidders to submit this information to the District within the time prescribed may result in the District's rejection of the Bid Proposal of such bidder as non-responsive. The District may, at its discretion, request that Bidders other than the three (3) lowest bidders submit this additional subcontractor information after the District's opening of Bid Proposals and prior to the District's award of the Contract.

16.2 Work of Subcontractors. All Bidders are referred to the Contract Documents and the notation therein that all Contract Documents are intended to be complimentary and that the organization or arrangements of the Specifications and Drawings shall not limit the extent of the Work of the Contract Documents. Accordingly, all Bidders are encouraged to disseminate all of the Specifications, Drawings and other Contract Documents to all persons or entities submitting sub-bids to the Bidder. The omission of any portion or item of Work from the Bid Proposal or from the sub-bidders' sub-bids which is/are necessary to produce the intended results and/or which are reasonably inferable from the Contract Documents is not a basis for adjustment of the Contract Price or the Contract Time. Dissemination of the Contract Documents to sub-bidders and dissemination of addenda issued during the bidding process is solely the responsibility of each Bidder.

16.3 Subcontractor Bonds. In accordance with California Public Contract Code §4108, if a Bidder requires a bond or bonds of its Subcontractor(s), whether the expense of procuring such bond or bonds are to be borne by the Bidder or the Subcontractor(s), such requirements shall be specified in the Bidder's written or published request for sub-bids. Failure of the Bidder to comply with these requirements shall preclude the Bidder from imposing bonding requirements upon its Subcontractor(s) or rejection of a Subcontractor's bid under California Public Contract Code §4108(b).

17. Workers' Compensation Insurance. Pursuant to California Labor Code §3700, the successful Bidder shall secure Workers' Compensation Insurance for its employees engaged in the Work of the Contract. The successful bidder

Subletting and Subcontracting [4100 - 4114]** (*Chapter 4 added by Stats. 1986, Ch. 195, Sec. 42.1.*)**4100.** This chapter may be cited as the "Subletting and Subcontracting Fair Practices Act."(*Added by Stats. 1986, Ch. 195, Sec. 42.1.*)

4101. The Legislature finds that the practices of bid shopping and bid peddling in connection with the construction, alteration, and repair of public improvements often result in poor quality of material and workmanship to the detriment of the public, deprive the public of the full benefits of fair competition among prime contractors and subcontractors, and lead to insolvencies, loss of wages to employees, and other evils.

(*Added by Stats. 1986, Ch. 195, Sec. 42.1.*)

4103. Nothing in this chapter limits or diminishes any rights or remedies, either legal or equitable, which:

(a) An original or substituted subcontractor may have against the prime contractor, his or her successors or assigns.

(b) The state or any county, city, body politic, or public agency may have against the prime contractor, his or her successors or assigns, including the right to take over and complete the contract.

(*Added by Stats. 1986, Ch. 195, Sec. 42.1.*)

4104. Any officer, department, board, or commission taking bids for the construction of any public work or improvement shall provide in the specifications prepared for the work or improvement or in the general conditions under which bids will be received for the doing of the work incident to the public work or improvement that any person making a bid or offer to perform the work, shall, in his or her bid or offer, set forth:

(a) (1) The name, the location of the place of business, the California contractor license number, and public works contractor registration number issued pursuant to Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code of each subcontractor who will perform work or labor or render service to the prime contractor in or about the construction of the work or improvement, or a subcontractor licensed by the State of California who, under subcontract to the prime contractor, specially fabricates and installs a portion of the work or improvement according to detailed drawings contained in the plans and specifications, in an amount in excess of one-half of 1 percent of the prime contractor's total bid or, in the case of bids or offers for the construction of streets or highways, including bridges, in excess of one-half of 1 percent of the prime contractor's total bid or ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), whichever is greater.

(2) An inadvertent error in listing the California contractor license number or public works contractor registration number provided pursuant to paragraph (1) shall not be grounds for filing a bid protest or grounds for considering the bid nonresponsive if the corrected contractor's license number is submitted to the public entity by the prime contractor within 24 hours after the bid opening and provided the corrected contractor's license number corresponds to the submitted name and location for that subcontractor.

(3) (A) Subject to subparagraph (B), any information requested by the officer, department, board, or commission concerning any subcontractor who the prime contractor is required to list under this subdivision, other than the subcontractor's name, location of business, the California contractor license number, and the public works contractor registration number, may be submitted by the prime contractor up to 24 hours after the deadline established by the officer, department, board, or commission for receipt of bids by prime contractors.



**DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE ("DVBE")
PARTICIPATION GOAL**

1. DVBE Participation Policy. The District is committed to achieving its established Participation Goal for Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises ("DVBEs"). Through the DVBE participation program, the District encourages contractors to ensure maximum opportunities for the participation of DVBEs in the Work of the Contract.

2. Definitions.

2.1 Disabled Veteran. A "Disabled Veteran" means a veteran of the military, naval, or air service of the United States with at least ten percent (10%) service-connected disability who is domiciled in the State of California.

2.2 Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise. A "Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise" ("DVBE") means a business enterprise certified by the Office of Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Services, State of California, Department of General Services, pursuant to Military and Veterans Code §999, or an enterprise certifying that it is a DVBE by meeting all of the following requirements: (a) it is a sole proprietorship at least fifty-one percent (51%) owned by one or more Disabled Veterans, or in the case of a publicly owned business, at least fifty-one percent (51%) of its stock is owned by one or more Disabled Veterans; or a subsidiary wholly owned by a parent corporation, but only if at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the voting stock of the parent corporation is owned by one or more Disabled Veterans; or a joint venture in which at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the joint venture's management and control and earnings are held by one or more Disabled Veteran; (b) the management and control of the daily business operations are by one or more Disabled Veterans; provided that the Disabled Veteran(s) exercising management and control of the business enterprise are not required to be the same Disabled Veteran(s) who is/are the equity Owner(s) of the business enterprise; and (c) it is a sole proprietorship, corporation, or partnership with its home office located in the United States and which is not a branch or subsidiary of a foreign corporation, foreign firm, or other foreign-based business. The terms "foreign corporation" "foreign firm" and "foreign-based business" shall be deemed to mean a business entity that is incorporated or which has its principal headquarters located outside the United States of America.

3. DVBE Participation Goal. The term "Participation Goal" is a numerically expressed objective for DVBE participation in performing the Work of the Contract. The Participation Goal is not a quota, set-aside or rigid proportion. The District has established a DVBE Participation Goal of Three Percent (3%) of the total Contract Price.

4. Monitoring of DVBE Participation and Submission of Report.

4.1 Certification of Participation. At the time of execution of the contract, the Contractor will provide a statement to the District of anticipated participation of Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises in the contract

4.2 Submission of Report. During performance of the Contract, Contractor shall monitor the Work of the Contract, award of subcontracts and contracts for materials, equipment and supplies for the purpose of determining DVBE participation in the Work of the Contract. Contractor shall report on a monthly basis all DVBE's utilized in the performance of the Work, the type or classification of the Work performed by each such DVBE and the dollar value of the Work performed by each such DVBE. In addition, upon completion of the Work of the Contract, Contractor shall submit a report to the District in the form attached hereto identifying all DVBEs utilized in the performance of the Work, the type or classification of the Work performed by each such DVBE and the dollar value of the Work performed by each such DVBE. The submission to the District of such report shall be deemed a condition precedent to the District's obligation to make payment of the Final Payment under the Contract Documents. The submission of such report shall be in addition to, and not in lieu of, any other conditions precedent set forth in the Contract Documents for the District's obligation to make payment of the Final Payment. The District reserves the right to request additional information or documentation from the Contractor evidencing efforts to comply with the DVBE Participation Goal.

4.3 Contract Audit. Contractor agrees that the District, or its designee, shall have the right to review, obtain and/or copy any and all writings, materials, documents and other records pertaining to the performance of the Contract. Contractor agrees that the District, or its designee, shall have access to any of Contractor's premises upon reasonable notice, during usual business hours for the purpose of interviewing employees and inspecting and/or copying such writings, materials, documents and other documents which may be relevant to a matter under investigation for the purpose of determining compliance with the DVBE Participation Goal.
