Chapter 3 – General Institution

BP 3505 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

The District shall have emergency response and evacuation procedures for notifying the campus community in the event of a significant emergency or dangerous situation involving an immediate threat to the health or safety of students or employees occurring on the campus.

The Board shall approve an emergency operations plan. The plan to be activated in the event of an emergency, or when a natural disaster or hazardous condition occurs. This plan shall comply with the National Incident Management System (NIMS), and the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS) and should incorporate the functions and principles of the Incident Command System (ICS), the Master Mutual Aid Agreement (MMAA), and any other relevant programs
