- Review of Minutes from May 9, 2019
 - A. Facilities Master Plan was discussed. The MP will direct the facilities planning through 2040. The DLR Group is the contractor who will conduct the Master Planning process which will involve all constituent groups of the college as well as the surrounding community. Charlie Yen is the Point of Contact for the college.
 - B. Ferris Kawar was elected as the Facilities Planning Subcommittee co-chair for the final meeting of the 2018/19 year. A new co-chair will be elected by the subcommittee in Fall 2019.
 - C. Gender Neutral bathrooms: the subcommittee discussed the needs of students in special populations (e.g., students who identify as transgendered). The committee discussed the need for new facility plans to incorporate gender neutral bathrooms. Language for a motion was considered and will be brought to a future meeting.
 - D. A fleet of 60 "street legal" utility carts have been purchased and will be used by Facilities O&M, Campus Police and other functions.
