OVERARCHING ISSUES

- 1. Web Sites
 - College web site should be updated to improve: information, appearance, navigation, links
 - A plan should be developed to ensure all college web sites (including program and faculty sites) are 508 accessibility compliant
- 2. Begin dialogue and curriculum review to develop student learning outcomes
- 3. Ensure effective data is collected and used to inform planning processes
 - Include the collection and analysis of data in the role of the Office of Institutional Research
 - Establish a process by which requests for support from Institutional Research are prioritized
 - Provide collegewide data as well as individual program data for program review
 - Do a follow-up study on the Eng 1 advisory
 - Encourage programs undergoing Program Review to conduct student surveys
 - Review recent research studies such as that comparing student success in 8 and 16 week courses and develop strategies based on study findings
- 4. Encourage innovation such as the development of on-line teaching supplements.
- 5. Encourage increased collaboration between and among programs to share ideas and resources
- 6. Encourage faculty to utilize on line resources for all classes
- Ensure the Occupational Education and Program Review Committees complete the guidelines for the mandated two year vocational program review cycle
- 8. As the Hay Study is completed ensure that job classifications are congruent with staffing needs rather than current assignments and assistance is provided to accurately determine those needs.
