DPAC Budget Subcommittee Update: Vice-President of Business/Administration Chris Bonvenuto provided an overview of the CCC Chancellor's Office budget requests to the State of California for \$478 million in on-going funds and \$239 million in one-time funds for 2026-2027. It does not include an extension of hold-harmless or one-time block grants.
