- a. Malibu Campus Operation Costs Estimates of Opening the campus in Spring 2023: total costs for Leadership and Support, Associate Dean, AA II, Student Services Specialist, Media Resources Assistant, 3 Campus Safety Officers, 3 Custodians, Grounds person, Supplies and Utilities(TBD) need to be built in to the Adopted Budget. Purpose of the Malibu Campus is to provide specific credit and non-credit courses for Malibu community, Monday through Friday 10 am to 6 pm. The annual total salary and benefits: FY 22-23 \$547,342, FY 23-24 \$1,142,310, FY 24-25 \$1,186,148, FY 25-26 \$1,234,185, FY 26-27 \$1,240,574
- b. <u>State Revenue News</u> Revenue figures are coming in below what was projected. Personal Income Tax is taking a downturn, showing a weakness in state revenue collection. The economy continues with high inflation, significant increase in interest rates with a decline in the stock market. This new information is an update from September 2022.
