IV. Reports/Discussion:

- Revenue and Expenditure Lines Description Tutorial
 Chris Bonvenuto explained the Unrestricted General Fund 01.0 Revenue and Expenditure accounts,
 line by line with examples.
- b. Student Centered Funding Formula (SCFF) Tutorial Chris Bonvenuto showed the Student Centered Funding Formula Calculator that can be changed to project an increase or decrease in funding based on changes in different metrics. There are three sections of the SCFF Calculator; Section #1 Base Allocation (70% of funding) the district receives for the number of students we serve, Section #2 Supplemental Allocation (20% of funding) for AB 540, PELL, Promise Grant recipients, Section #3 Student Success Allocation (10% of funding) the district receives funding for only one of the metrics such as: Associate Degrees for Transfer, Associate Degree, BA Degree Granted, Credit Certificate, Transfer to Four-Year University, etc.
- c. Fiscal Services Update The Budget Committee will work on ideas to make a recommendation to DPAC and the Superintendent/President to close the gap on the deficit in the 2023-2024 District Budget. The Committee will discuss solutions to close the gap during the next meeting on May 17, 2023.
