- a. P2 and State Adopted Budget Chris presented the changes in the State Budget from January to the May Revise to Final Adopted Budget. The following is the list of major items that changed from the May Revise to Final Adopted Budget, received on-going funding: SCFF Base Increase, Student Success Completion Grants, NextUp, California Promise Expansion, Basic Needs, Rising Scholars, AANAPI Student Achievement, Physical Plant/Instructional Equipment, Discretionary/Block Grant, and Native American Student Success Programs. The High-Skill Fields Preparation and Teaching Credential Partnerships did not receive funding.
- b. <u>Summer Time Budget Planning</u> Two important upcoming dates: The CCCCO Budget Workshop will be held on August 25, 2022 and the District closes the Accounting Records on August 31, 2022. The Budget Office will work on finalizing the figures and Chris Bonvenuto will present the Final Adopted Budget to the Budget Committee on September 7, 2022.
