Focus on long-term plans to improve student learning and achievement	Action Projects are NOT used by the ACCJC to determine if the college is meeting accreditation standards
❖ Identify responsible parties	Action Projects need to be grounded in data, evidence, and remain consistent with the findings of the college's Institutional Self Evaluation Report, aka the Self Study
