## IV. Discussion

a. There was consensus to present the Tentative Budget in July 2020 to the District due to Chancellor's Office extending the college district financial reporting requirement deadline. Currently SMC's deficit surpasses reserves.

Chris Bonvenuto shared the following:

- b. An outline of the economic impact of Covid-19, Stay-At-Home Order and the Governor's May Revise Budget showing State sources of revenue, taxes: personal income, sales, corporation, all decreased and will have a direct impact on the district's funding. Listed programs to continue current funding levels, changes to SCFF, Hold Harmless to continue through June 30, 2024. Provided District Specific items eliminated from previous proposal/budget and listed items eliminated that could be reinstated if Federal Funds are provided on a one-time basis.
- c. Multi Year Budget Unrestricted General Fund-Five Year Fiscal Year 2017-18 thru 2022-23 showing additional expenses along with drops in funding, results in \$13,000,000 additional cuts required in 2020-21 to adopt a budget with 5% Fund Balance.
