Public Comments - None

A. Discussion - Contract Education Pilot Program for International Students: Teresita Rodriguez, Vice-President of Enrollment Development, provided an update of the pilot program developed to meet the needs of international students on F-I visas for Fall 2010. Originally, eight courses were proposed, seven were offered through AC College Associates as contract education, serving approximately I25 international students. There were no student complaints about the cost of the courses. The pilot program appears to be successful by providing the classes these international students needed to maintain their F-I student visas.

Concern was expressed about (I) the specific company that contracted with the college to provide this contract education pilot program and (2) that the idea of offering this contract education was not presented and discussed by DPAC before implementation. There was disagreement as to whether this was a planning or operational issue.

B. Institutional Effectiveness Matrix: Teresita Rodriguez distributed the 2010 Institutional Effectiveness Matrix which is built around the five District supporting goals – Innovative and Responsive Academic Environment, Supportive Learning Environment, Supportive Collegial Environment, Stable Fiscal Environment, and Sustainable Physical Environment. Each section contains a set of performance indicators that provide a gauge for how well the college is doing in terms of meeting the supporting goals.

The Institutional Effectiveness Report will be presented to the Board of Trustees at its meeting on November 2nd. The full report will be posted on the SMC website and will be presented to DPAC at its next meeting.
