Budget Update - Governor's May Revise

The May Revision reflects the net changes to the state economic outlook and the corresponding effects on the State's obligations and spending

- State revenues are estimated to be \$2.4B over January estimates
- o Increased cost to Medi-Cal is projected to be \$1.2B
- o Rainy Day Fund to be funded at \$1.6B
- o Proposal to address Cal STRS unfunded liability (\$74.4B)
- o Increased state revenues did not translate into more money for education as anticipated
- Maintains January budget with few changes
- o Governor continues to demonstrate fiscal prudence and restraint and to pay down the "wall of debt"
- o Governor has crafted a remarkable turnaround for California's current and future fiscal condition

Assembly and Senate Budgets

- o COLA at 1.7%
- o Access at 2.75%
- More money to Categorical Programs
- o Increase to Scheduled Maintenance and Instructional Equipment
- Conference Committee submits budget bill to Governor by June 15th
- o Adopted Budget more likely to resemble May Revision July 1st
