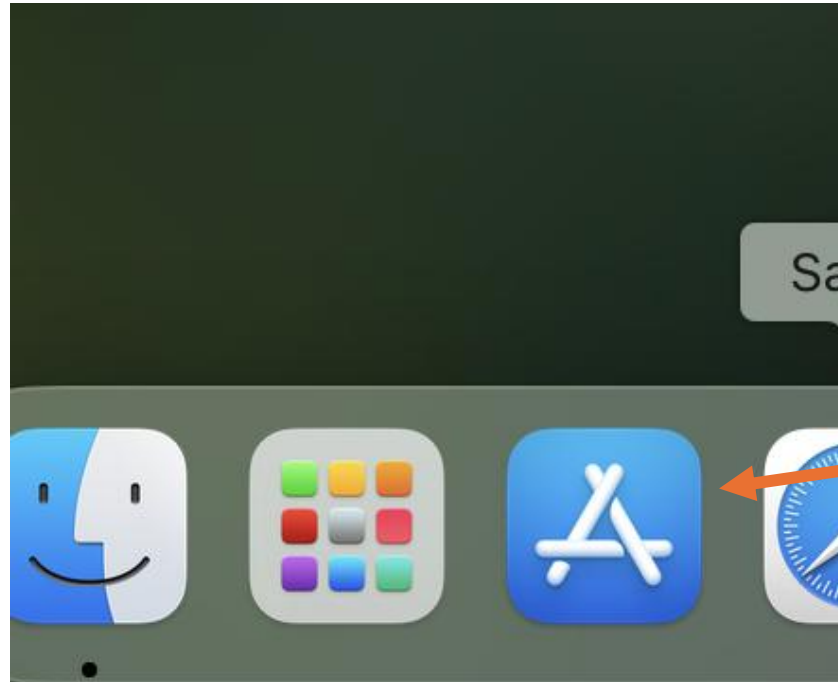

How-To Install and Setup Guide For

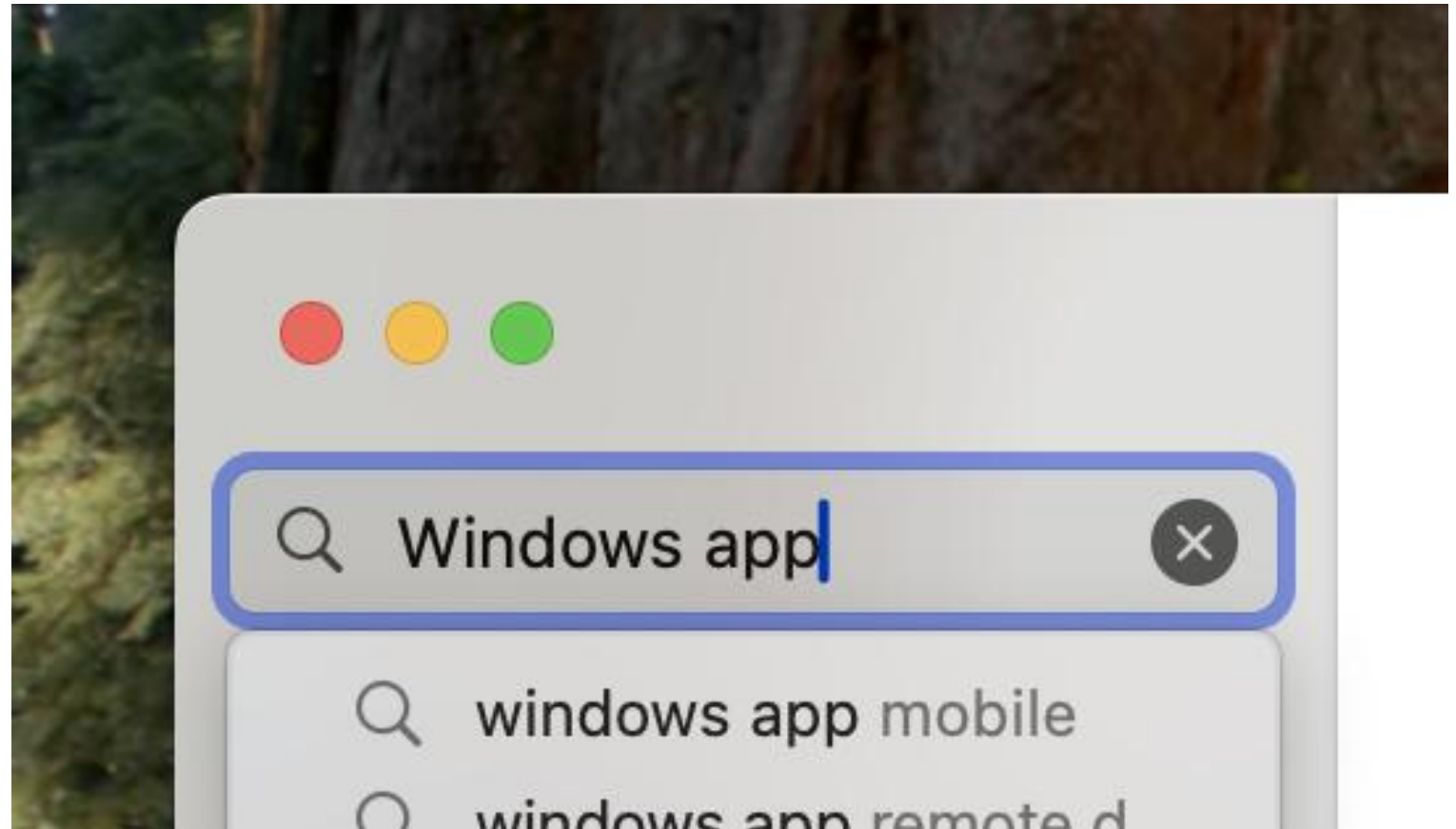
Windows App on Mac Devices

Open the “App Store” app in your Mac computer.

Or search for it on the Web.

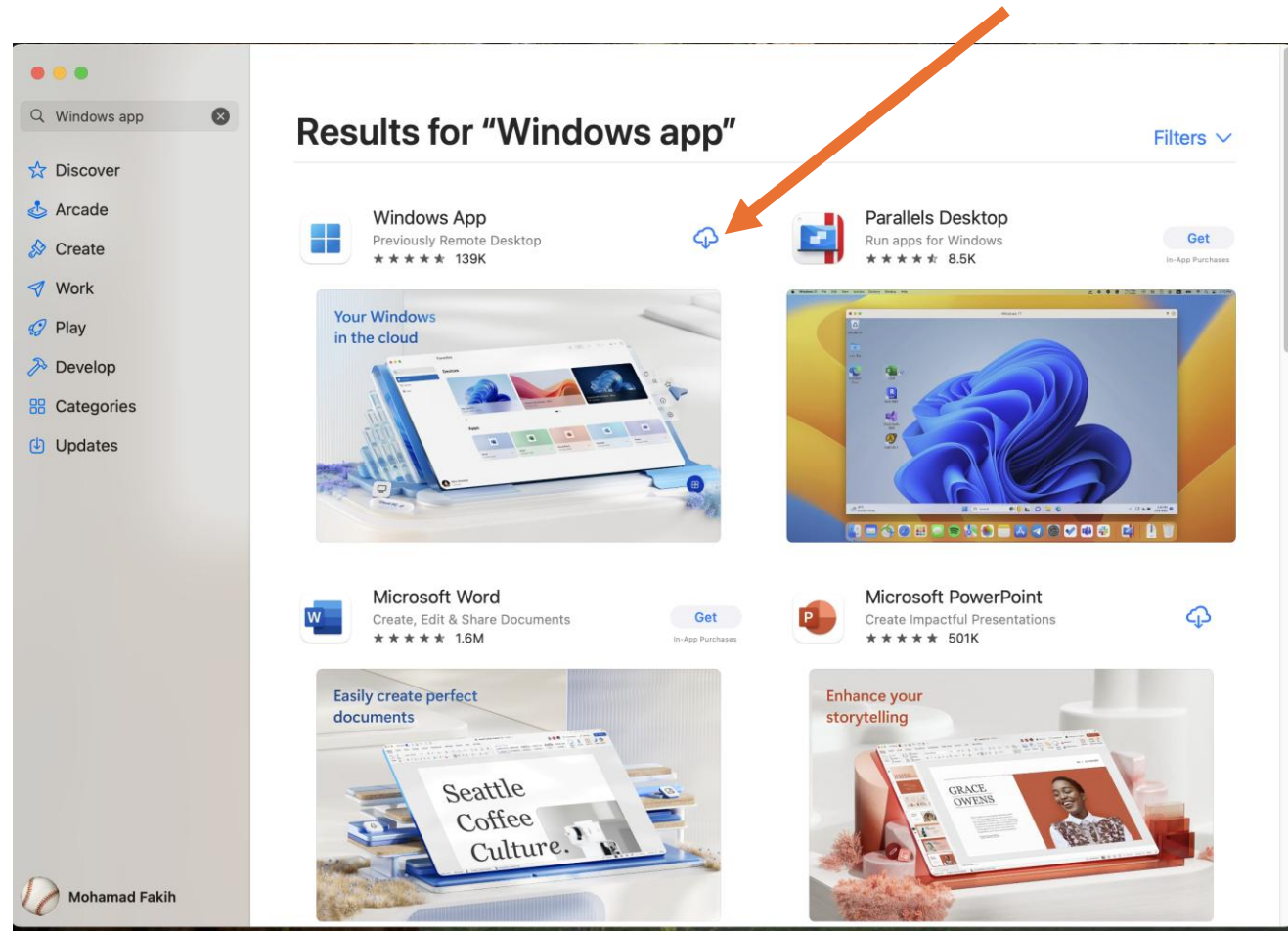


Search for:
“Windows App”

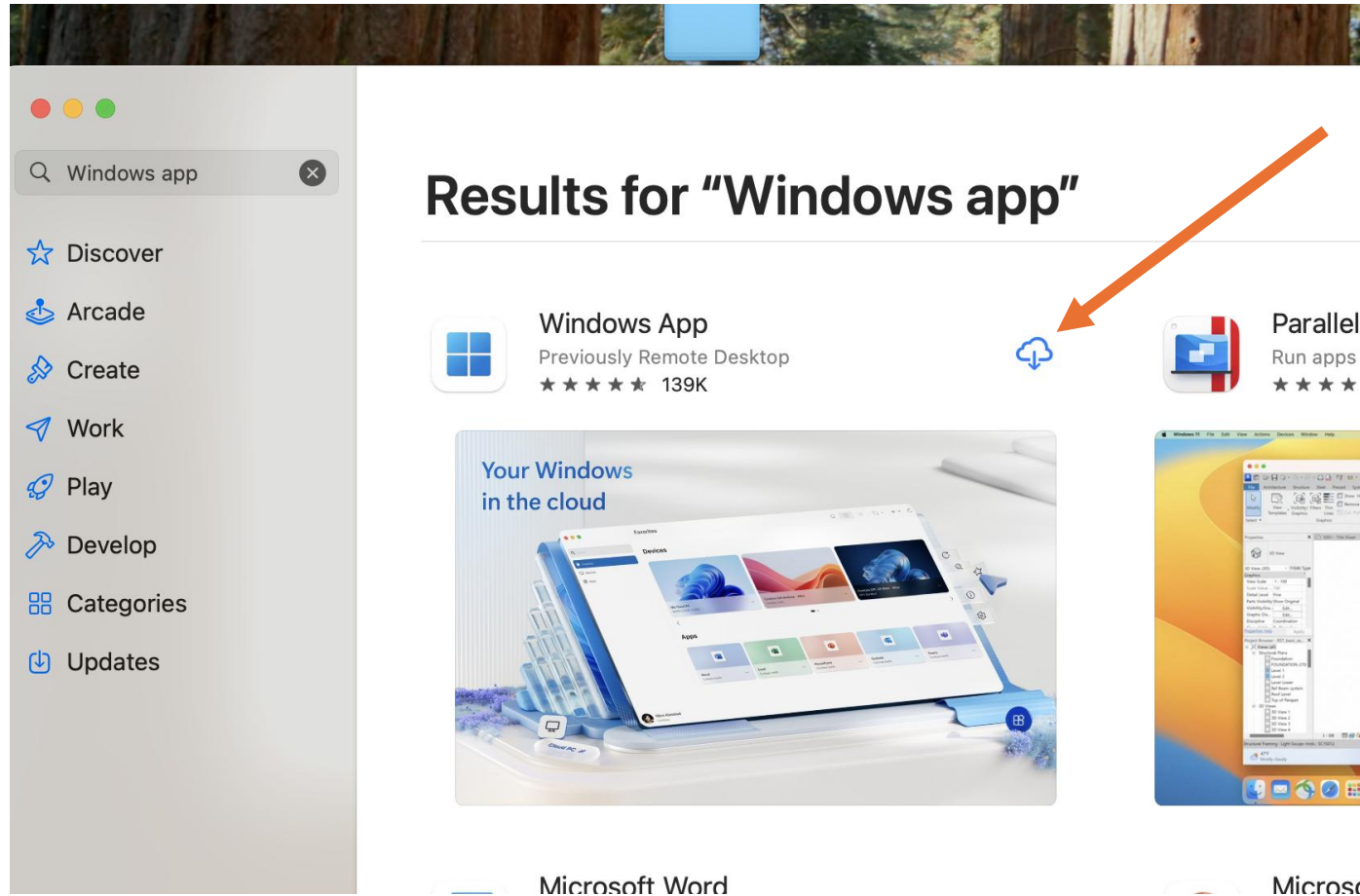


- Locate the app in the search results.

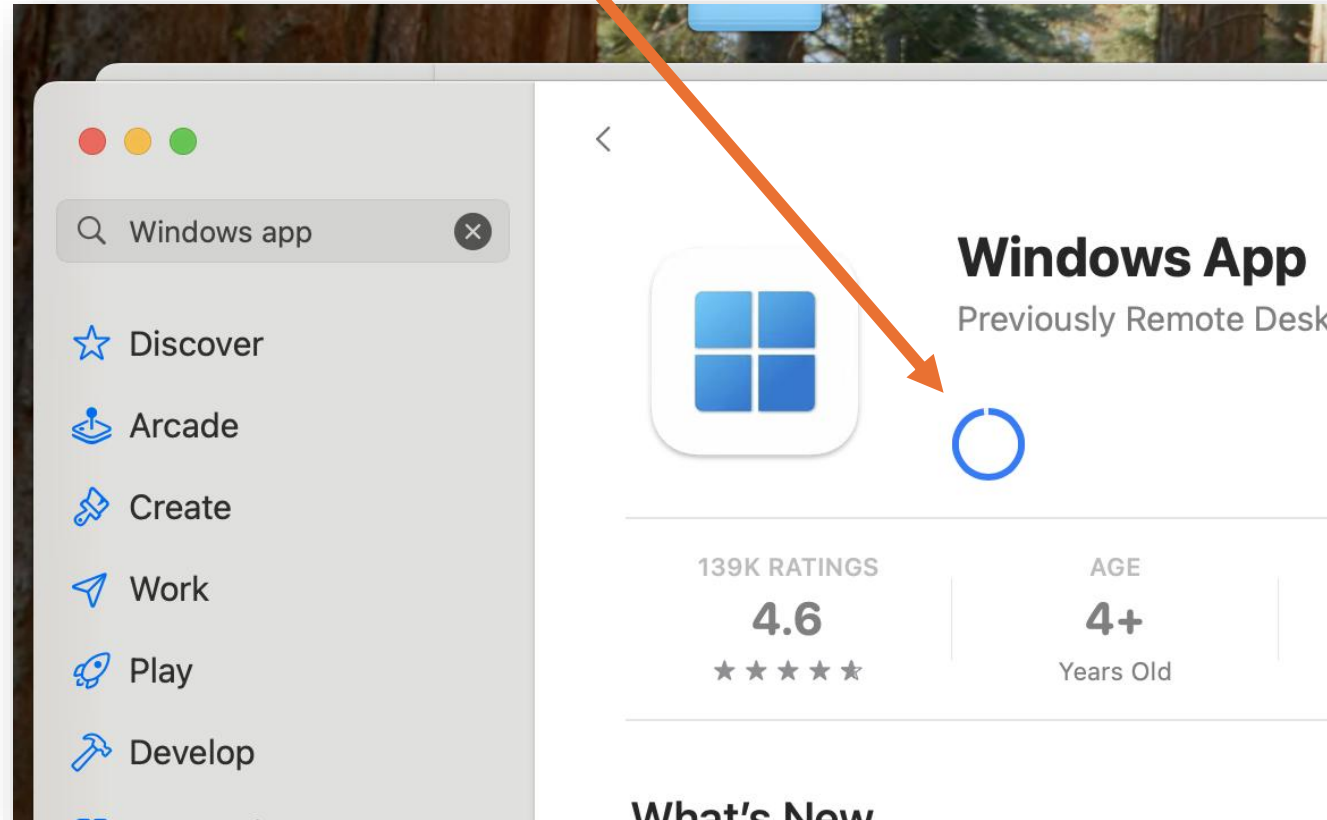
Click on the cloud icon to start downloading.



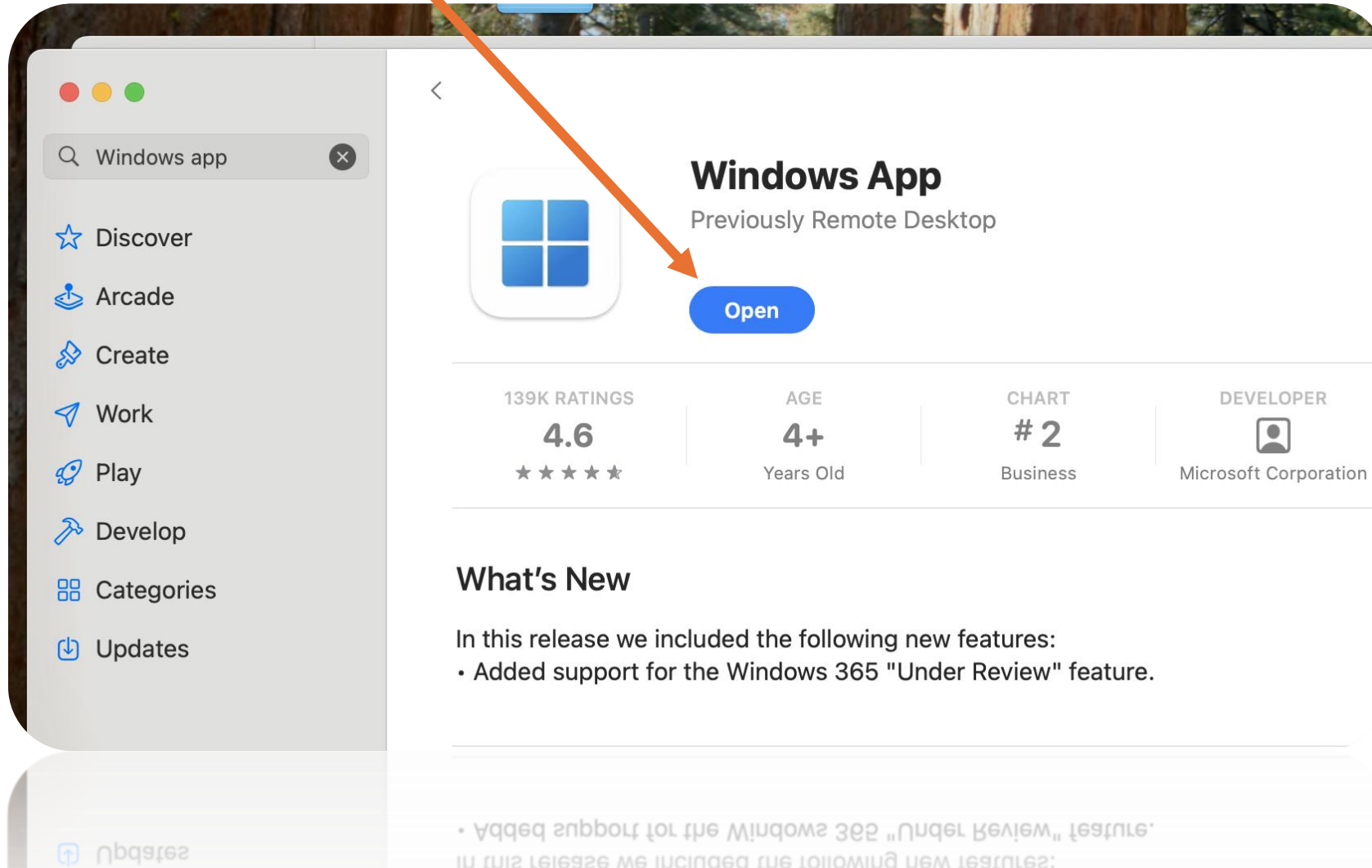
Locate the Windows App in the result.



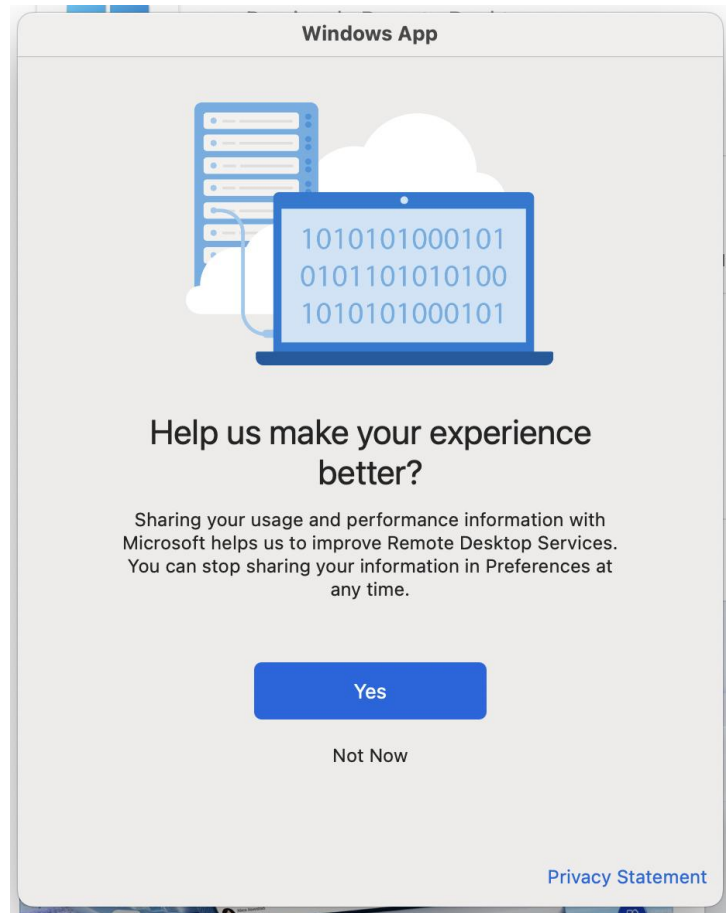
Wait for the download to complete.



When the download completes, click the “**Open**” button.



If you see the following prompt, click either ‘Yes’ or ‘Not Now’ based on your preference. Either option will work to get the app installed.



Read the writing of the prompt and click on “Next”

You may click “Skip”.
But It’s recommended to read it.

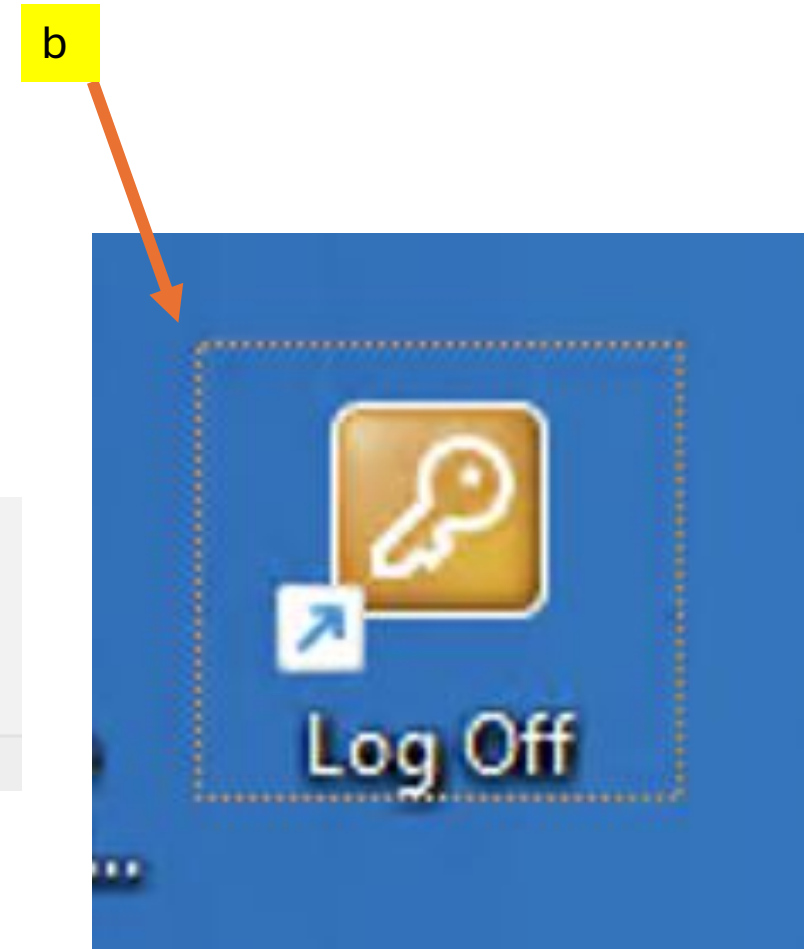
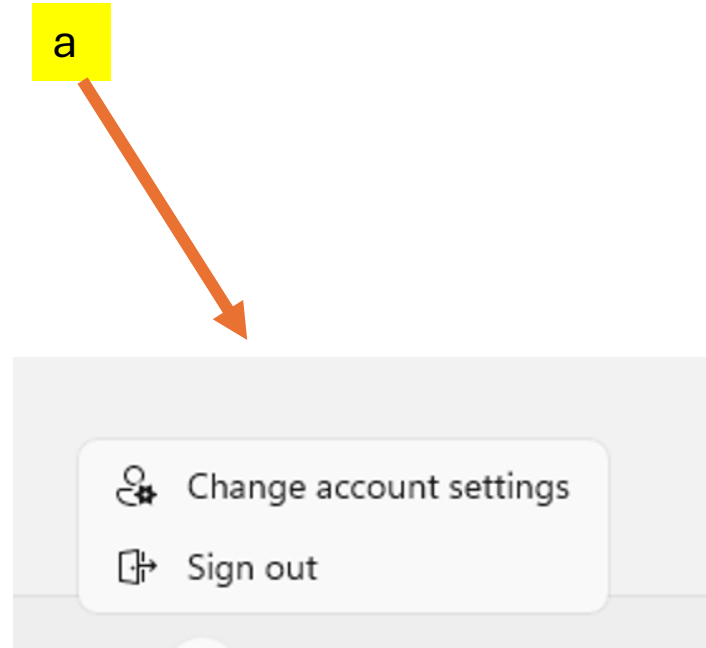
If you want to start OneDrive app to save your files look for the OneDrive icon on the desktop or next to the clock on the right bottom corner.
