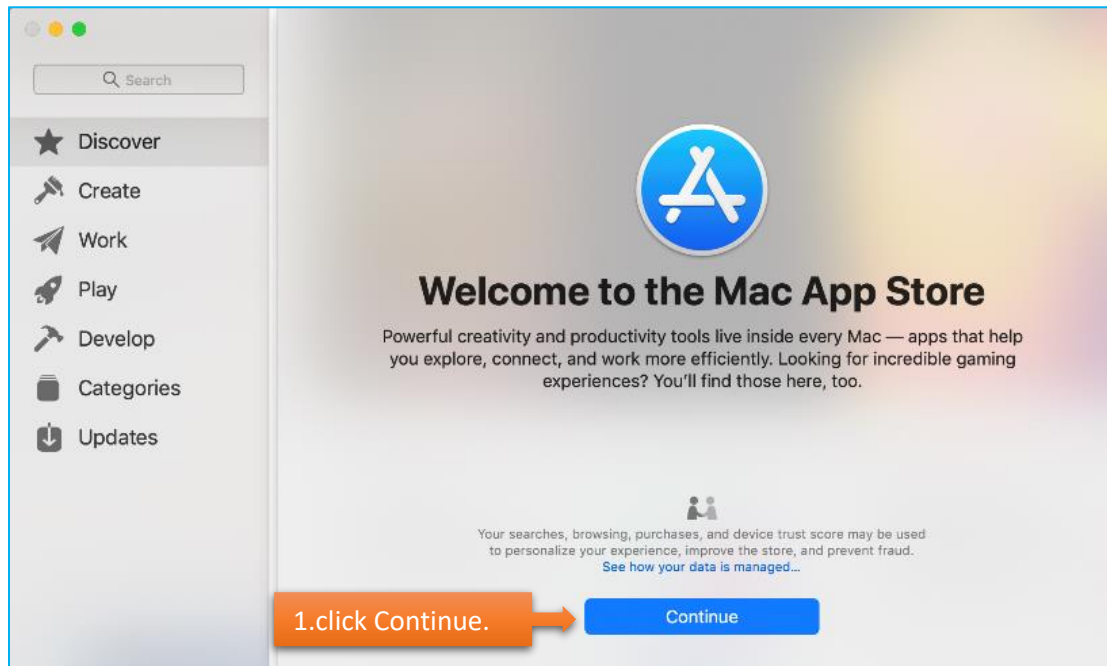


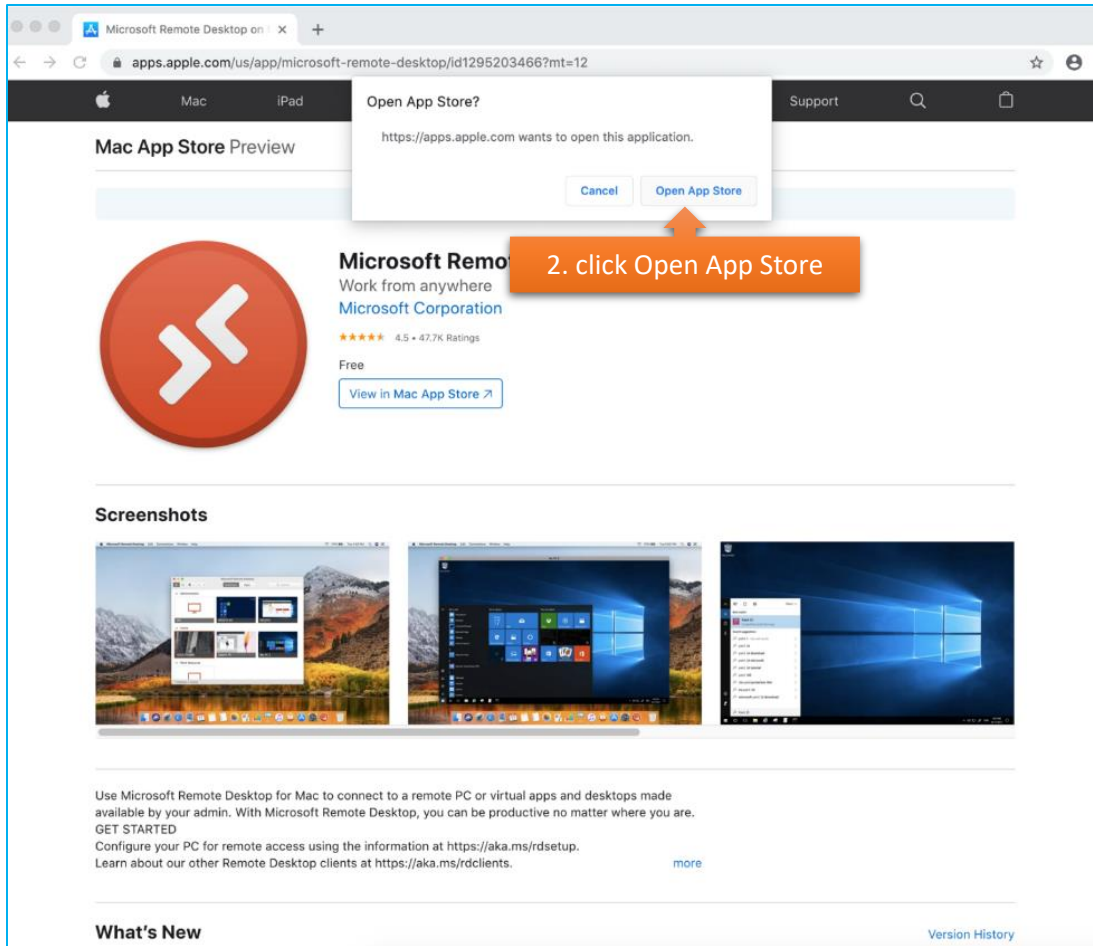
Installing Microsoft Remote Desktop on a Mac device (OSX) such as iMac, MacBook,...etc.
