











(Open-Ended) When you think of college, which schools come to mind first? Name three.



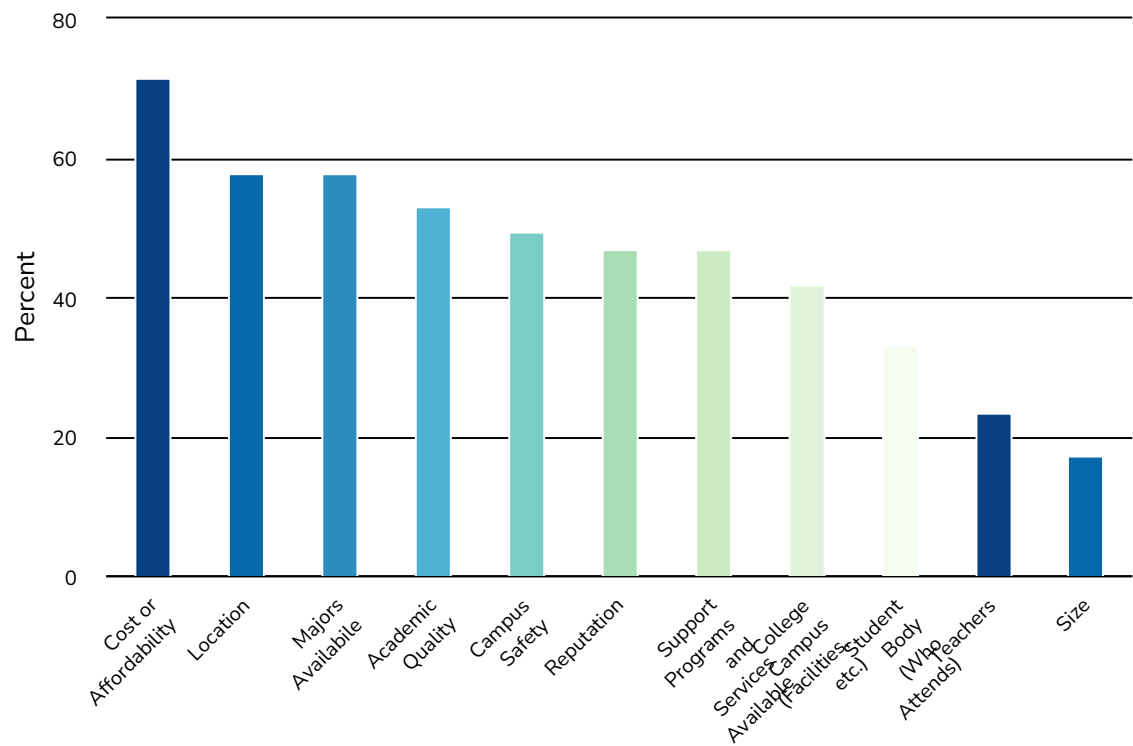
# 1. What is the most important factor in choosing a college?














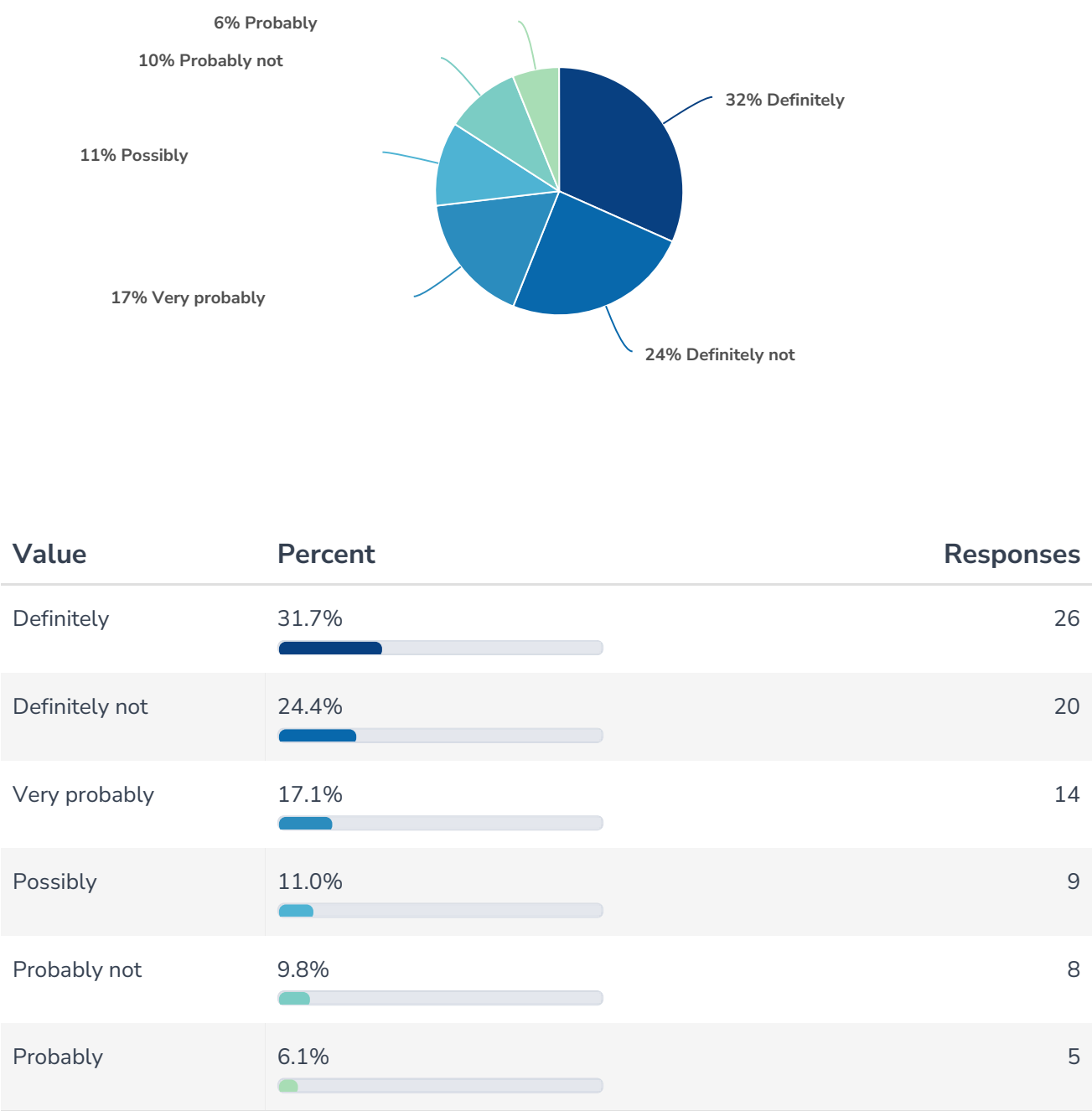

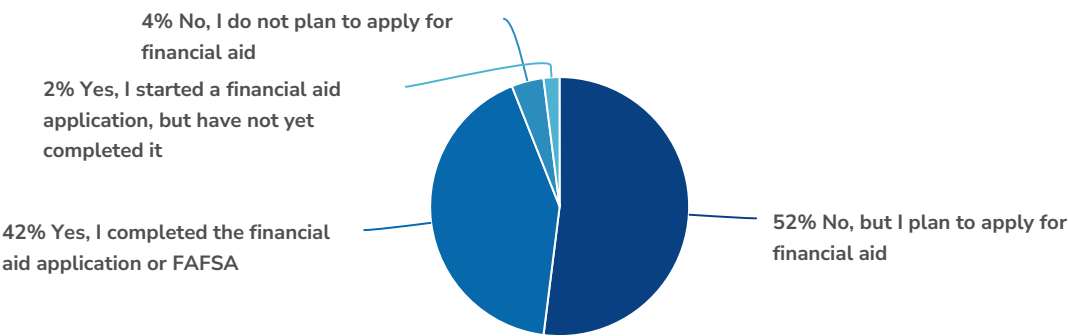
- Santa Monica College (N = 10)

- Personal - relocating, cannot afford

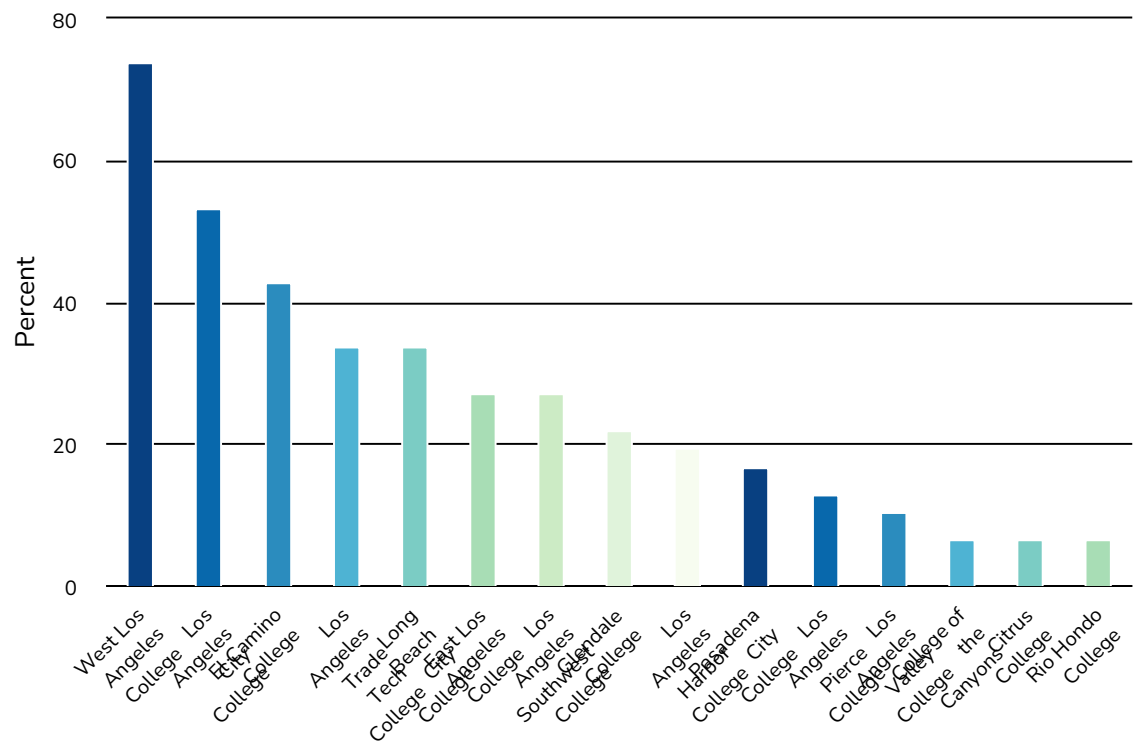

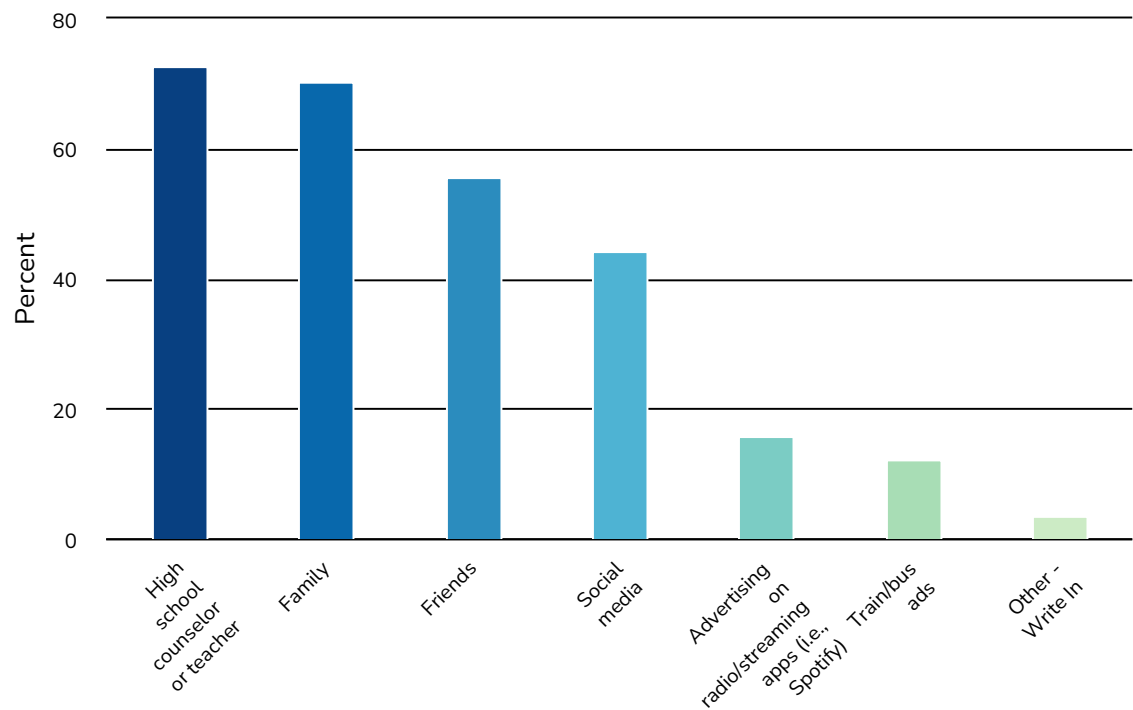

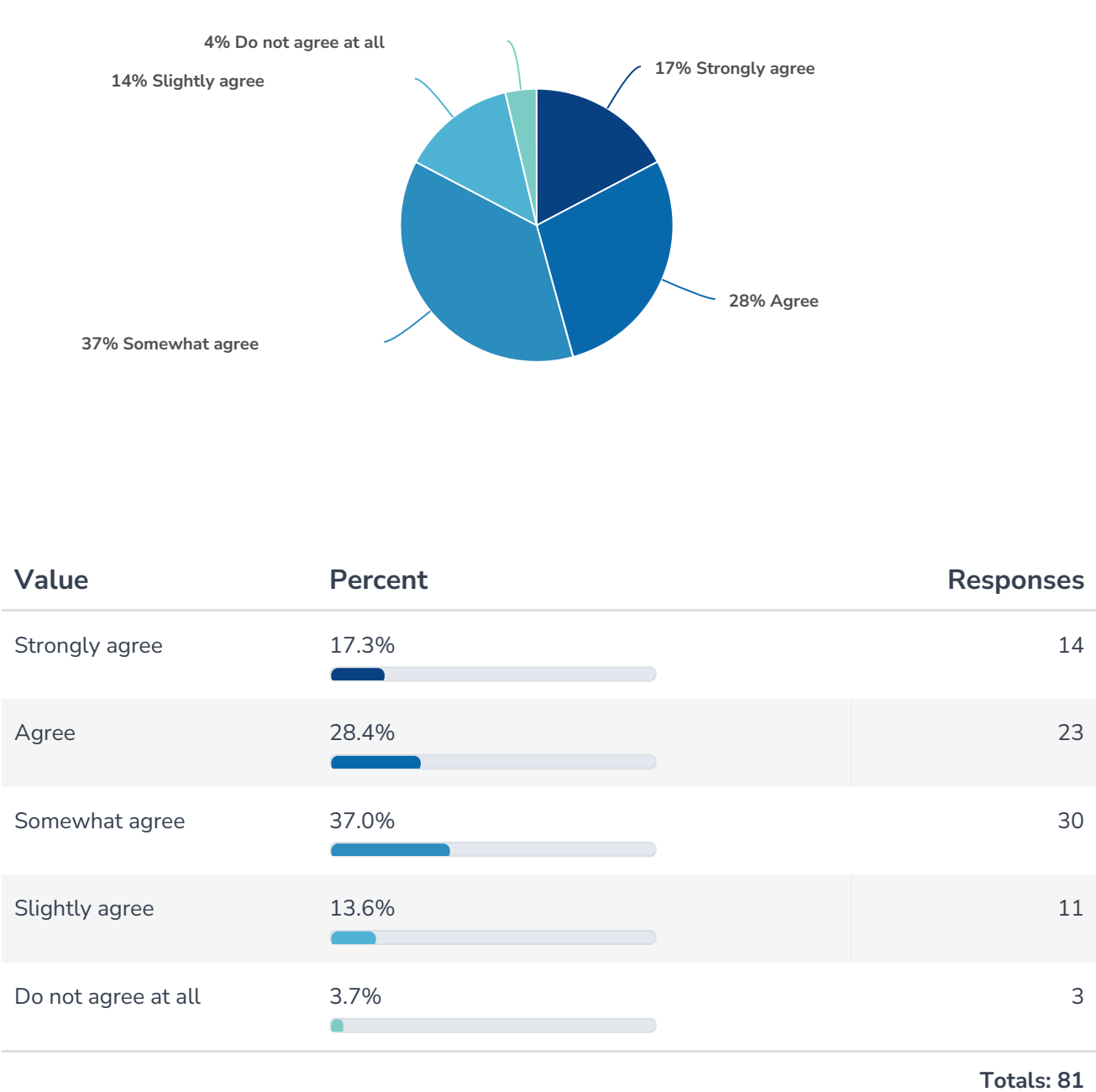

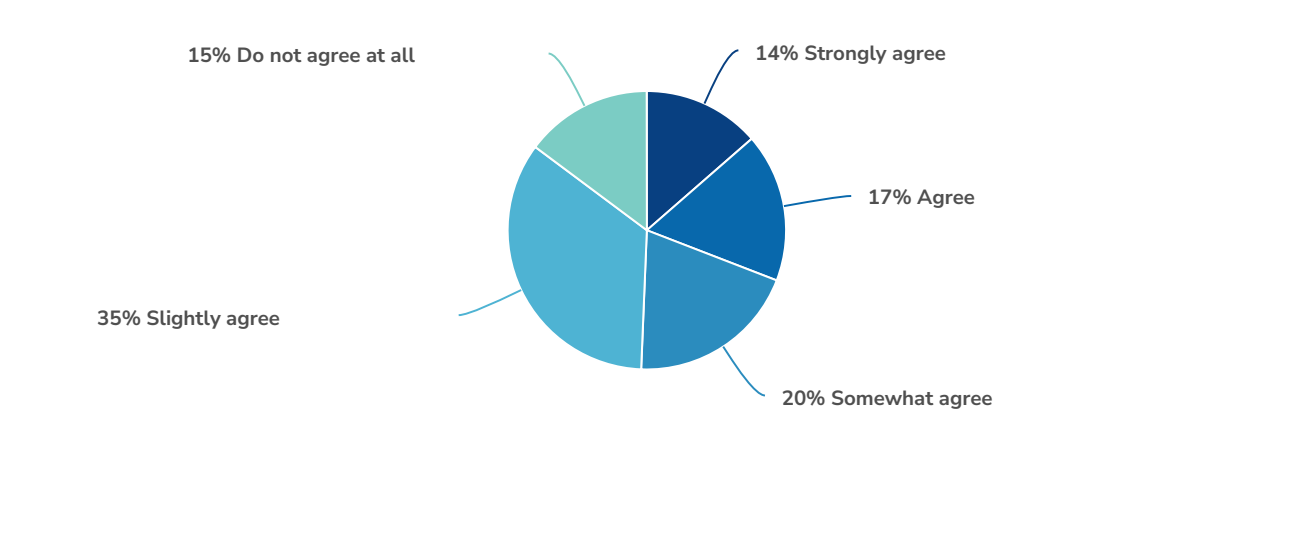

7. To what extent do you agree with the statement: "College is worth the cost in the long run"

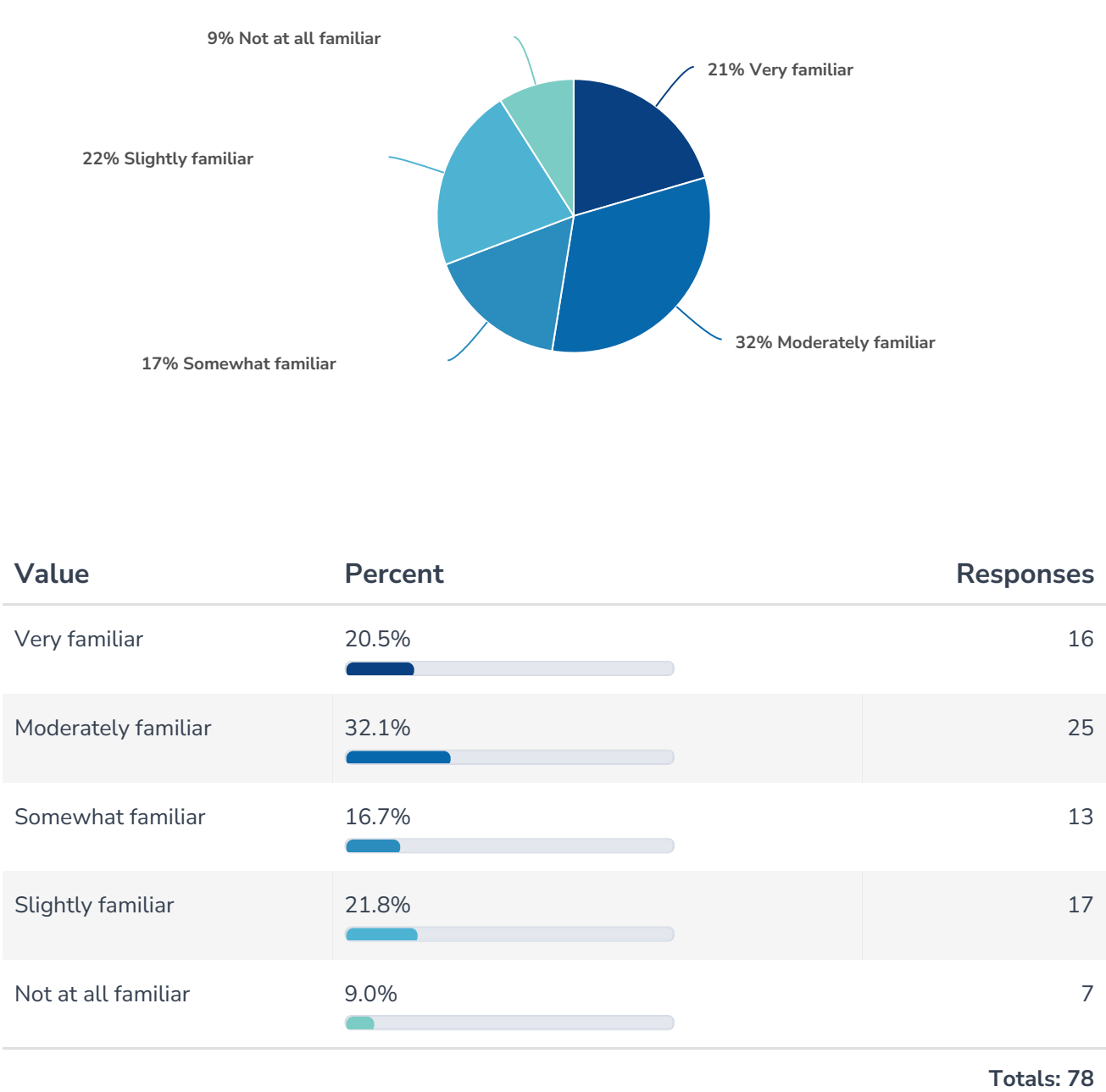


8. To what extent do you agree with the statement: "A college degree is necessary to be successful in life"



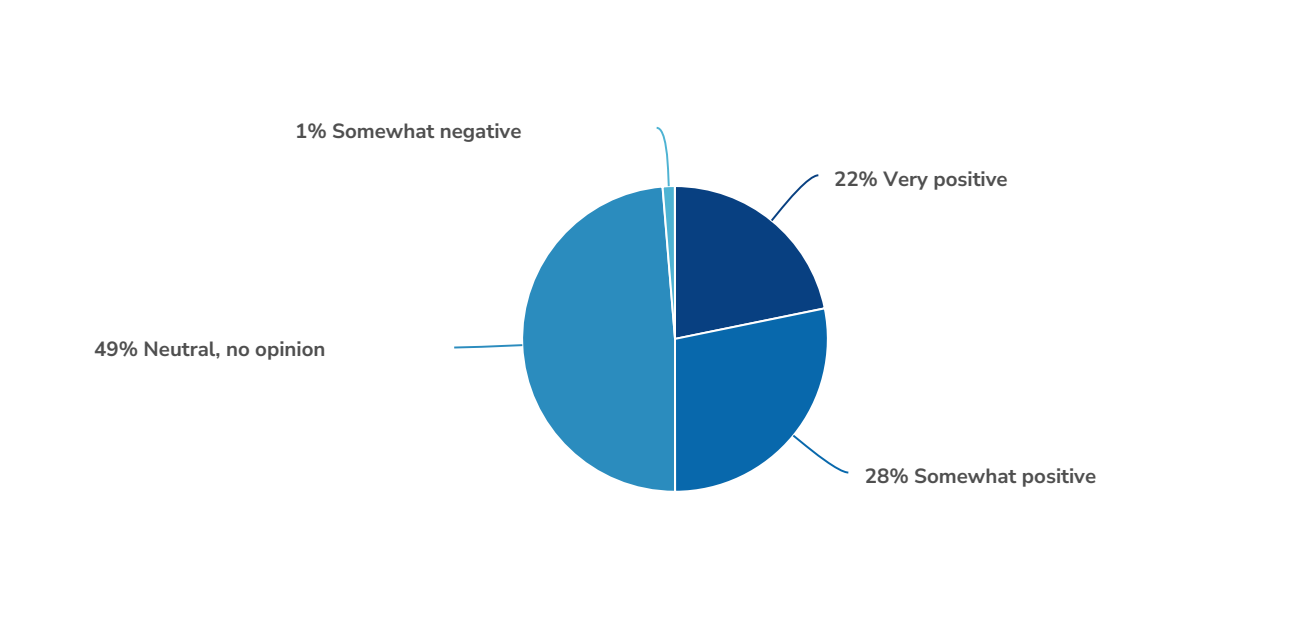

10. What is your overall opinion of Santa Monica College?

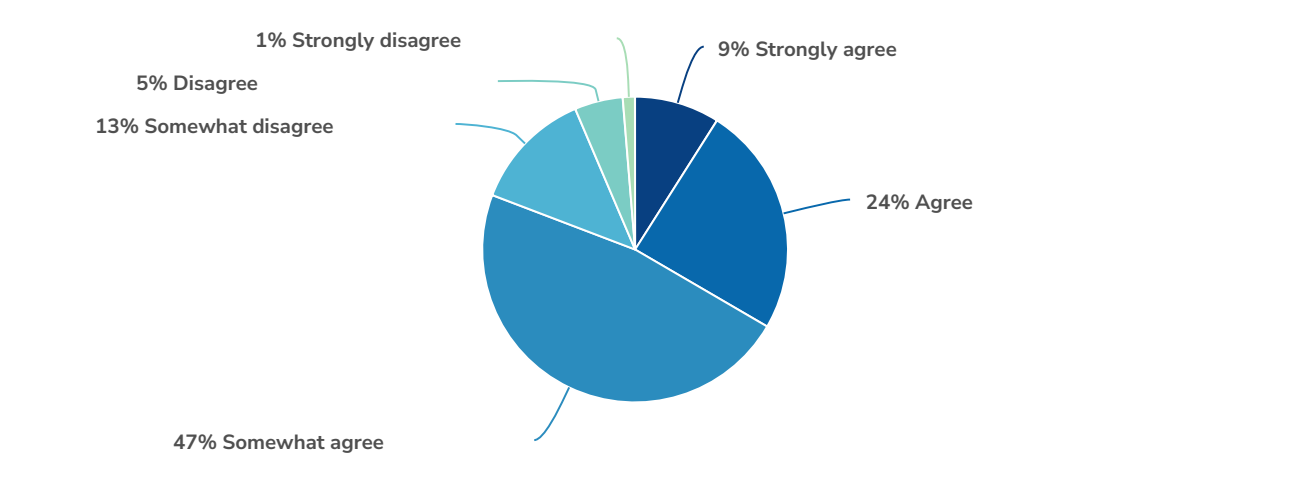
