



(Open-Ended) When you think of college, which schools come to mind first? Name three.




1. What is the most important factor in choosing a college?







(Open Ended) Among students who said they were "possibly", "probably not", or "definitely not" enrolling in college in 2023-2024, the reasons cited included:


- Not eligible to enroll because they are too young (freshmen)

4. Have you applied for financial aid for any college?












8. To what extent do you agree with the statement: "A college degree is necessary to be successful in life"





10. What is your overall opinion of Santa Monica College?


