

2024 STUDENT TRANSPORTATION TRENDS



A total of 646 students completed the survey



2.8%

85.6% Took at least one class on campus



About 26% of survey respondents reported taking classes on campus exclusively, 59.5% took courses that were a combination of on campus & online, and 14.4% took classes exclusively online

16.7% Experienced financial strain related to their transportation budget



Around 17% of survey respondents stated that the cost of transportation puts a significant strain on their budget (N=533)

> 2.3% Used electric vehicle to school



An electric vehicle was used for 2.3% of the commutes to SMC campuses.

60.3% Felt safe while walking to/from campus

Two in three students said they either strongly agreed (23.8%) or agreed (36.5%) with the statement: I feel safe walking to/from campus (N=874)

37.5% We<u>re</u> aware that SMC has EV charging stations



Approximately 38% of survey respondents were aware of the EV charging stations available on SMC campus (N=203)

> 66.5% Lives within a short



Approximately 66.5% of students are located within 10 miles of the SMC campus

Felt safe while biking to/from campus



Just under half of students said they either strongly agreed (13.4%) or agreed (22.9%) with the statement: I feel safe biking to/from campus (N=387)

3% Use the EV charging



Only 3% of survey respondents use the EV charging stations daily (N=203)
