Santa Monica College did not have in place a guided self-placement in ESL in 19-20. We just implemented it in April 2021.

In the case of Math, alternate placement rules (from the CCCCCO default model) were in place in Statistics/Liberal Arts Math, which placed students with a HS GPA < 2.3 into pre-stats or intermediate algebra on their first semester. This was changed to the default placement rule in April 2021 since our validation study concluded that our local model was not better at improving throughput. The same was true for BSTEM which placed students with a HSGPA ≤ 2.6 and no Precalculus; as well as those who did not complete HS Algebra 2 (or higher) into Intermediate Algebra in their first semester. Again, since local validation did not improve matters, we formally adopted the default placement model in April 2021. We also removed below-college level courses from our Math Guided Self-Placement Process.
