




### 3. Are you taking classes at any other institutions?


### 4. How much experience did you have with distance education and online learning prior to March 2020?






### 8. How comfortable are you using Canvas (the college's online learning platform)?




## 13. Have you received unemployment compensation/insurance?


## 14. Have you received SNAP (food stamps)?

## 15. Have you received emergency aid from your college?






## 16. Have you received emergency aid from outside of your college?


### 17. How has your employment changed as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic? (Check all that apply.)




20. In the last 30 days, did you ever cut the size of your meals or skip meals because there wasn't enough money for food?

## 21. In the last 30 days, how often did this happen (you cut the size of your meals or skipped meals because there wasn't enough money for food)?




### 22. In the last 30 days, did you ever eat less than you felt you should because there wasn't enough money for food?











### 35. What is your gender?



## 36. Do you identify as transgender?




