
## Santa Monica College 2019 STUDENT TRANSPORTATION TRENDS

## 934

Of of the 31,103 students invited to participate in the survey, a total of 934 students completed the survey for a response rate of 3%.

## Primary Commute Mode (% of Respondents)



10.89 Miles traveled each way



On average, students reported traveling 10.89 miles each way from their home to the main campus

Took at least one class on campus



About 65% of survey respondents reported taking classes on campus exclusively, 5% exclusively online, and 30% took courses that were a combination on campus and online Used SMC Lyft Shared in Fall 2019



About 8% of students said they used the free Lyft Shared program offered by SMC to travel between the main and satellite campuses after 6 pm **79%**Were satisfied with SMC

Among those who used it, 79% reported being satisfied (26%) or very satisfied (53%) with the SMC Lyft Shared program

Felt safe while walking to/from campus



About two in three students said they agreed (41%) or strongly agreed (26%) with the statement: I feel safe walking to/from campus (N = 855) **50%**Felt safe while biking to/from campus



Half of students said they agreed (33%) or strongly agreed (17%) with the statement: I feel safe while biking to/from campus (N = 481) 70%
Have used Big Blue Bus
to commute



About 70% of students said they have used the Santa Monica Big Blue Bus to commute to/from campus at least once during the semester 40%
Have used Metro LA
train/rail to commute



About 40% of students said they have used the Metro Los Angeles train/rail system to commute to/from campus at least once during the semester

30% Have used Metro LA bus to commute



About 30% of students said they have used the Metro Los Angeles bus system to commute to/from campus at least once during the semester Have used Culver City
Bus to commute



About 7% of students said they have used the Culver City bus system to commute to/from campus at least once during the semester 21%
Said cost of transportation was a big challenge



Over 21% of said the cost of transportation negatively impacted their budget "a great deal"; another 27% said it affected their budget "a moderate amount" **3.28**Average Vehicle Ridership (AVR)



The ratio of students per car arriving on campus during peak commuting hours (6 am - 10 am and 3 pm - 7 pm) was 3.28 students/car (including ride share alone)



An online survey was administered to all enrolled students (not on the "do not contact" list) 10/28/2019 to 11/18/2019 about their commute patterns between 10/21/2019 and 10/25/2019
