  - > 3.28% from last Fall
- Fall **CREDIT FTES** Down
  - ▶ ↓ 0.51% from last Fall
- Fall **NON-RESIDENT FTES** Down
  - 7.61% from last Fall



#### Key Findings

- California:
  - ► HS graduates projected to decline ↓ 29%
- Out-of-State:
  - New York = 130 new students enrolled in 24-25, HS graduates projected to decline ↓ 27%
  - Florida = new students enrolled in 24-25,
    HS graduates projected to increase
    ↑ 12%
  - Washington 23 new students enrolled in 24-25, HS graduates projected to decline ↓ 8%
  - Texas = 22 new students enrolled in 24-25, HS graduates projected to increase
     5%
  - Illinois = 19 new students enrolled in 24-25, HS graduates projected to decline
     ↓ 32%

### International Student Enrollment Challenges

- Strength of the US Dollar
- Fear of Uncertainty
  - ▶ F1 Visas
    - More difficulty and/or wait time for visa appointments
    - Increased scrutiny
    - Increased visa denials
  - Travel Bans
  - Ability to Complete Course of Study
    - Fear of abrupt termination
    - Proposed elimination of Duration of Stay, requiring fixed end not to exceed 4 years
  - Increased Competition
- > Spring 2026
  - Applications down 40%
  - Admissions down 71%
