





2. Are you currently enrolled at a California community college?







5. How long have you been taking courses at your California community college?






7. When you search for courses at your college, how clear is it that the courses offered are in-person, online, hybrid, or hyflex?

8. In your time at your community college, have you ever taken courses in any of the following modalities? (Check all that apply)

















25. Why have you not accessed your college's support/resources to navigate online learning? (check all that apply)




27. How do you believe AI technology impacts the learning experience for students?




30. What type of course was it?








52. What best describes your gender identity?



54. Did either of your parents/guardians attend college or attain an associates degree or higher?




55. Do you consider yourself to be a single parent?



56. Are you currently employed?






58. Do you have a disability?




