RICOH Copier Burglary



Suspect: Male, light complexion, 20 – 30 years old, 5'09", medium build, dark wavy hair, and light beard or goatee. He was last wearing sunglasses, green cargo shorts, green T-shirt, black backpack, and white shoes.

On 04/15/2011 at approximately 12:25 p.m., a suspect entered the 1st floor west side doors of the Business building and proceeded to pry open the copy machine money hatch using a crowbar and black gloves that he carried in his backpack. The suspect used the guise of a maintenance worker in order to avoid suspicion. At 12:51 p.m., the suspect left in a west bound direction. The total loss was \$115.00 dollars.
